X/4 CS - FOREIGN TROOPS^{SP} INTERFERE WITH WORK IN KOSICE

MUNICH, SEPT 3 (CMD) - THE EAST SLOVAK RADIO SAID TODAY FOREIGN TROOPS WERE INTERFERING WITH RAILWAY WORK AT KOSICE.

THE RADIO SAID A "SPECIAL SITUATION" HAS ARISEN IN KOSICE.

IT SAID A WHOLE TRAIN FULL OF FOREIGN SOLDIERS HAS TAKEN UP RESIDENCE ON ONE OF THE SIDINGS.

"THIS FOREIGN COMMODITY WHICH CANNOT RPT NOT BE UNLOADED INTERFERES WITH THE SMOOTH COURSE OF RAILWAY WORK BECAUSE THE ACCESS TO FREIGHT CARS IS DIFFICULT AS THE ACCESS ROADS ARE NOT RPT NOT FREE," THE RADIO SAID.
