X/4 C/S - JUDICIAL BODIES FOR OBSERVANCE OF LAWS

MUNICH, SEPT 3 (CMD) -- ALL CZECHOSLOVAK JUDICIAL BODIES ARE DETERMINED TO "INSIST FULLY ON THE OBSERVANCE" OF THE COUNTRY'S LAWS, RADIO PRAGUE REPORTED, TONIGHT.

THE RADIO SAID CZECHOSLOVAK MINISTER OF JUSTICE BOHUSLAV KUCERA TODAY CONVENED, TOGETHER WITH THE COMMISSIONER OF THE SLOVAK NATIONAL COUNCIL FOR JUSTICE AND THE CHAIRMAN OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK SUPREME COURT, A NATIONWIDE CONFERENCE OF THE CHAIRMEN OF REGIONAL COURTS.

THE RADIO SAID THAT "THE RESULTS OF THE SESSION UNAMBIGUOUSLY CONFIRMED THE DETERMINATION OF ALL THE JUDICIAL ORGANS TO INSIST FULLY ON THE OBSERVANCE OF CZECHOSLOVAK LAWS AND TO PROTECT THE INTERESTS OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK SOCIALIST STATE, AS THEY ARE EXPRESSED IN OUR LAWS."

RADIO PRAGUE SAID THAT "OUR JUDICIAL ORGANS WILL CONTINUE TO BE A GUARANTEE OF PRIVATE RIGHTS OF CITIZENS, WILL PROTECT THE ENTIRE SOCIETY AGAINST ILLEGAL INTERVENTIONS."

"THE RADIO SAID "THE CZECHOSLOVAK ORGANS CAN ALLOW INTERVENTIONS IN PRIVATE RIGHTS OF CITIZENS ONLY IF THESE ARE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE VALID CZECHOSLOVAK LAWS."
