X/4 CS - SLOVAK CONSOLIDATION PROGRAM DISCUSSED

MUNICH, SEPT 3 (CMD)- THE PRESIDUM OF THE SLOVAK NATIONAL COUNCIL MET TODAY IN BRATISLAVA AND DISCUSSED THE DRAFT OF A SHORT-TERM CONSOLIDATION PROGRAM OF SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC LIFE IN SLOVAKIA, RADIO BRATISLAVA REPORTED TONIGHT.

THE RADIO SAID THE DRAFT PROGRAM WAS DISCUSSED IN CONNECTION WITH THE ENTRY OF THE ARMIES OF FIVE WARSAW PACT COUNTRIES INTO CZECHOSLOVAK TERRITORY.

THE MEETING WAS PRESIDED OVER BY THE CHAIRMAN OF THE SLOVAK NATIONAL COUNCIL, ONDREJ KLOKOC.

THE RADIO SAID THAT THE PRESIDUM OF THE SLOVAK NATIONAL COUNCIL ADOPTED MEASURES WHICH WILL BE ENSURED WITHOUT DELAY BY THE INDIVIDUAL MINISTERIAL COMMISSIONS OF THE SLOVAK NATIONAL COUNCIL. THE MEASURES AIM PARTICULARLY AT ENSURING REGULAR PRODUCTION TO MAKE GOOD AS SOON AS POSSIBLE ON THE SHORTAGES OF PRODUCTION WHICH HAVE ARISEN.

THE RADIO SAID THAT THE COUNCIL PRESIDUM APPEALED TO THE PUBLIC TO APPROACH "WITH INITIATIVE AND ORGANIZATION" THE TASKS AIMING AT THE CONSOLIDATION OF ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL LIFE IN ALL SECTORS.

THE PRESIDUM ALSO COUNTED ON THE INITIATIVE OF THE YOUTH WHICH CAN SIGNIFICANTLY HELP IN THE AUTUMN FIELD WORK, THE RADIO SAID.

THE RADIO SAID THE PRESIDUM HAS CHARGED THE CHAIRMEN OF THE COMMISSION OF PEOPLE'S CONTROL OF THE SLOVAK NATIONAL COUNCIL TO PRESENT ONCE A WEEK TO THE MEMBERS OF THE PRESIDUM AN INFORMATION ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE SHORT-TERM CONSOLIDATION PROGRAM IN SLOVAKIA.
