

X/4 CURT - GERMANS, MAGYARS BACK CEAUSESCU

MUNICH, SEPT. 3 -- (CMD) -- INTELLECTUALS OF TWO RUMANIAN MINORITY GROUPS -- THE GERMANS AND MAGYARS -- HAVE SENT TELEGRAMS SUPPORTING THE COUNTRY'S FOREIGN AND DOMESTIC POLICIES, THE RUMANIAN NEWS AGENCY AGERPRES REPORTED TODAY.

THE TELEGRAMS CAME FROM THE MAGYAR AND GERMAN INTELLECTUAL GROUPS IN BUCHAREST

THE MAGYAR TELEGRAM ALSO URGED WITHDRAWAL OF WARSAW PACT TROOPS FROM CZECHOSLOVAKIA. IT SAID THE SPEEDIEST WITHDRAWAL OF THE TROOPS WOULD ALLOW "THE PEOPLE OF FRATERNAL CZECHOSLOVAKIA TO FREELY UNFOLD THE ACTIVITY CROWNED WITH SUCCESS ON THE ROAD OF SOCIALIST CONSTRUCTION."

THE MAGYAR GROUP SAID IT WHOLEHEARTEDLY SUPPORTED THE POLICIES OF RUMANIAN PARTY GENERAL SECRETARY NICOLAE CEAUSESCU WHICH IT SAID ARE "BASED ON THE FUNDAMENTAL PRINCIPLES OF SOVEREIGNTY AND INDEPENDENCE OF THE HOMELAND, OF THE EXPANSION OF COOPERATION WITH ALL SOCIALIST STATES, ON THE OBSERVANCE OF MUTUAL ESTEEM AND NON-INTERFERENCE IN THE INTERANL AFFAIRS, EXPANSION OF COOPERATION WITH ALL COUNTRIES OF THE WORLD."

THE TELEGRAM FROM THE GERMAN INTELLECTUALS SAID:

"EACH PARTY HAS THE RIGHT AND LIBERTY TO SOLVE ALL THE PROBLEMS THAT ARISE IN ITS COUNTRY ACCORDING TO ITS OWN JUDGEMENT, TAKING INTO ACCOUNT ITS OWN TRADITIONS AND EXPERIENCE, THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE UNITY AND FRIENDSHIP OF THE SOCIALIST COUNTRIES, OF THE COMMUNIST AND WORKERS PARTIES."
