X/4/9 C/S - WARSAW SAYS NEW SOVIET PLENUM NOT EXCLUDED

MUNICH, SEPT 3 (CMD) - RADIO WARSAW'S CORRESPONDENT IN MOSCOW, JOSEF WIELOWSKI, SAID TONIGHT THAT "THE CONVENING OF A NEW PLENUM OF THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE OF THE SOVIET PARTY IS NOT RPT NOT EXCLUDED IN CIRCLES OF OBSERVERS" IN MOSCOW.

THE CORRESPONDENT SAID THAT THE EVENTS IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA AND THE OVERALL SITUATION CONNECTED WITH THESE EVENTS CONTINUE TO BE IN THE CENTER OF ATTENTION OF SOVIET PUBLIC OPINION.

"IN REPORTS FROM PRAGUE IT IS POINTED TO THE PROGRESSING NORMALIZATION OF THE SITUATION IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA, AND AT THE SAME TIME IT IS STRESSED THAT IT WOULD BE PREMATURE TO THINK THAT COMPLETE CALM HAS RETURNED THERE.

"IT IS NOT THE PRODUCTION WHICH IS THE MOST IMPORTANT THING, WHICH CAN BE RESTORED TO THE PREVIOUS STATE IN A MATTER OF FEW DAYS OR AT MOST FEW WEEKS.

"THE MAIN TASK CONSISTS IN THE STRUGGLE FOR WINNING OVER THE HEARTS AND CONSCIENCE OF THE PEOPLE. THIS IS HOW THE PROGRAM OF ACTION WAS FORMULATED BY ONE OF THE CZECH SPEAKERS IN HIS TALKS WITH THE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SOVIET PRESS," SAID THE COMMENTATOR.

HE ADDED THAT "CENTRIFUGAL FORCES" WHICH DID NOT RPT NOT ADMIT THEIR DEFEAT ARE ACTING INSIDE CZECHOSLOVAKIA AND OUTSIDE IT.

HE SAID THAT THE SOVIET PRESS WAS CONDUCTING SHARP POLEMICS WITH DIFFERENT CENTERS OF WESTERN PROPAGANDA.

"THE SOVIET COMMENTATORS ALSO STRESS THAT THE LEADERS OF WEST GERMANY WANT TO USE THE SITUATION IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA ABOVE ALL FOR THEIR MILITARIST AND REVANCHISTS AIMS," HE SAID.
