X/4 C/S - ADN UNHAPPY OVER NEW ISSUE OF RUDE PRAVO

PRAGUE, SEPT 3 (CMD) - EAST GERMANY'S OFFICIAL ADN NEWS AGENCY TODAY EXPRESSED ITS REGRET OVER THE FAILURE OF "RUDE PRAVO," THE CZECHOSLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY ORGAN, TO CARRY THE TEXT OF THE MOSCOW COMMUNIQUE WHICH FOLLOWED THE RECENT SOVIET-CZECHOSLOVAK TALKS.

ADN ALSO EXPRESSED ITS SURPRISE OVER RUDE PRAVO'S FAILURE TO ENGAGE IN A "CONFRONTATION WITH OPEN AND HIDDEN COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARY GROUPS."

THE NEWS AGENCY SAYS THE ONLY TIME RUDE PRAVO EVEN MENTIONS THE WORDS COUNTER REVOLUTION IS IN A QUOTATION OF POLISH PREMIER JOZEF CYRANKIEWICZ.

IN ITS DESCRIPTION OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK SITUATION, ADN GOES ON, HOWEVER, TO NOTE THAT A NORMALIZATION IS NOTICEABLE ON THE ECONOMIC SECTOR. IT SAID THAT REPORTS FROM ALL REGIONS OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA SPEAK OF "OUTSTANDING PRODUCTION RESULTS."

THE NEWS AGENCY DESCRIBES AS ONE OF THE "MOST OUTSTANDING EVENTS" OF THE PAST 24 HOURS THE PRAGUE GOVERNMENT'S SESSION OF MONDAY NIGHT, WHICH HAD ADOPTED CERTAIN MEASURES TO DEAL WITH THE PRESS AND OTHER ISSUES, WHICH "STILL CONSTITUTE AN OBSTACLE OF PUBLIC LIFE."

ADN SAID "SUCH OBSTACLES ARE STILL NUMEROUS. THE MOST OBVIOUS ARE THE SMALL AND BIG PROVOCATIONS OF COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARY GROUPINGS, WHICH TRY TO ATTRACT THE ATTENTION OF THE PRAGUE PUBLIC."
