CSSR SOCCER TO RESUME

PRAGUE, SEPT 3 (UPI)- CZECHOSLOVAKIS SOCCER LEAGUE SEASON, INTERRUPTED BY THE CURRENT POLITICAL EVENTS, WILL BE RESUMED ON SEPTEMBER 15, PRAGUE RADIO REPORTED TODAY.

THE RESUMPTION OF THE LEAGUE SEASON, ORIGINALLY PLANNED FOR THE COMING WEEKEND, HAD TO BE DELAYED BECAUSE OCCUPATION SOLDIERS HAVE "SETTLED DOWN" ON VARIOUS SOCCER GROUNDS SUCH AS TEPLICE, NORTHERN BOHEMIA, AND KOSICE, SLOVAKIA, THE BROADCAST SAID.

IT IS STILL UNKNOWN WHETHER CZECHOSLOVAKIA WILL PLAY DENMARK AS SCHEDULED ON SEPTEMBER 25 IN COPENHAGEN. "PREPARATIONS FOR THIS GAME HAVE BEEN BADLY HAMPERED BY RECENT EVENTS," CZECHOSLOVAK NATIONAL COACH JOSEF MARKO SAID, ACCORDING TO PRAGUE RADIO.

POLISH GLIDER PILOT KILLED

WARSAW, SEPT 3, REUTER--A RECORD-SETTING POLISH GLIDER PILOT, MR. STANISLAW JOZEF CZAK, WAS KILLED, TOGETHER WITH A PUPIL, WHEN A PLANE IN WHICH THEY WERE MAKING A TRAINING FLIGHT CRASHED NEAR NOWY TARGIN, SOUTH POLAND, IT WAS ANNOUNCED TODAY.

MR. JOZEF CZAK WAS WELL-KNOWN FOR RECORD-BREAKING HIGH-ALTITUDE FLIGHTS IN TWO-SEATER GLIDERS AND SET A WORLD MARK BY REACHING 11,680 METERS (ABOUT 35,039 FEET) IN A POLISH "BOCIAN" GLIDER TWO YEARS AGO, THE OFFICIAL NEWS AGENCY PAP REPORTED.

MORE MONEY ASKED FOR BBC E. EUROPE BROADCASTS

LONDON, SEPT 3, REUTER - SIX LABOUR MEMBERS OF PARLIAMENT HERE TODAY ASKED THE GOVERNMENT TO GIVE MORE MONEY TO THE BRITISH BROADCASTING CORPORATION (BBC) TO MAINTAIN INCREASED BROADCASTS TO EASTERN EUROPE.

SINCE WARSAW PACT TROOPS INVADED CZECHOSLOVAKIA THE BBC HAS STEPPED UP CZECHOSLOVAK LANGUAGE BROADCASTS FROM 17 TO 24 HOURS A WEEK.

BROADCASTS IN RUSSIAN, POLISH, HUNGARIAN AND BULGARIAN HAVE ALSO BEEN INCREASED.
