X/4 C/S - SLOVENE QUESTIONS VALUES OF SOCIALISM UNDER VIOLENCE

MUNICH, SEPT 4 (CMD) - THE PRESIDENT OF THE SLOVENE REPUBLICAN ASSEMBLY YESTERDAY QUESTIONED THE "SOCIAL, HISTORIC AND HUMANE VALUE OF SOCIALISM ... AND ... ITS FUTURE, IF VIOLENCE ... IS BEING COMMITTED IN ITS NAME ..."

SPEAKING ON THE 25TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE FORMATION OF THE BELA KRAJINA 15TH PARTISAN SHOCK BRIGADE, SERGEY KRAIGHER TOLD AN AUDIENCE OF 15,000 AT METLIKA, YUGOSLAVIA, THAT MILLIONS THE WORLD OVER AND IN YUGOSLAVIA, QUESTIONED THE VALUES OF SOCIALISM IF VIOLENCE, "SUCH AS THE OCCUPATION OF SOCIALIST CZECHOSLOVAKIA, IS BEING COMMITTED IN ITS NAME AGAINST THE COMMUNISTS, THE WORKING CLASS, AND THE PEOPLES OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA AND THEIR LEGAL CONSTITUTIONAL ORGANS."

HE SAID THAT THE YUGOSLAV LEAGUE OF COMMUNISTS CENTRAL COMMITTEE HAD AT ITS RECENT 10TH SESSION GIVEN ITS ANSWER TO THE "VIOLENT CHARACTER OF THE OCCUPATION AND ITS CONSEQUENCES FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF PEACE AND SOCIALISM IN THE WORLD AND THE WORKERS' MOVEMENT, AND ESPECIALLY THE COMMUNIST MOVEMENT."
