X/4/9 C/S - WARSAW QUOTES ADN ON HAJEK-BRANDT SECRET MEETING

MUNICH, SEPT 4 (CMD) - RADIO WARSAW SAID LAST NIGHT THAT THE EAST GERMAN NEWS AGENCY, ADN, HAD REPORTED THAT WEST GERMAN FOREIGN MINISTER WILLY BRANDT MET CZECHOSLOVAK FOREIGN MINISTER JIRI HAJEK SECRETLY IN VIENNA ON JUNE 10.

"APART FROM THIS INFORMATION, WHICH WAS KEPT SECRET UP TO NOW, IT HAS ALSO BEEN REVEALED THAT BRANDT PRESENTED TO HAJEK THE SO-CALLED GRADUAL PLAN FOR TEARING THE CZECHOSLOVAK SOCIALIST REPUBLIC AWAY FROM COMECON.

"THIS PLAN INCLUDED, AMONG OTHER THINGS, OFFERS OF CREDITS AND PROPOSALS CONCERNING INDUSTRIAL COOPERATION," SAID THE BROADCAST, QUOTING ADN.

(CMD: THE BROADCAST DID NOT SAY WHO REVEALED THIS PLAN.)

THE RADIO ALSO QUOTED ADN, AS SAYING THAT WEST GERMAN INTELLIGENCE AND THE AMERICAN CENTRAL INTELLIGENCE AGENCY TOOK ADVANTAGE IN PAST WEEKS OF TRANSMITTERS OF WEST GERMAN AMATEURS TO SEND CODED INFORMATION TO COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARIES IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

THE BROADCAST SAID THAT OVER 40 AMATEUR TRANSMITTERS WERE USED FOR THIS PURPOSE. (RADIO WARSAW DOMESTIC/M, SEPT 3, 2300)
