RADIO BRATISLAVA ADDED: "THE EDITORIAL OFFICES HAVE SELECTED RESPONSIBLE COMRADES FROM AMONG THEIR RANKS WHO WILL SUPERVISE THAT THE JOURNALISTS WRITE IN THE SPIRIT OF THE MOSCOW AGREEMENT, IN THE LINE OF THE EXTRAORDINARY CONGRESS OF THE COMMUNIST PARTY OF SLOVAKIA AND OF THE GOVERNMENT DECISIONS.

"CHAIRMAN OF THE SLOVAK NATIONAL FRONT'S CENTRAL COMMITTEE SAMUEL FALTAN REPORTED ON THE SITUATION WITHIN AND ON PROPOSALS CONCERNING THE WORK OF THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE OF THE SLOVAK NATIONAL FRONT," RADIO BRATISLAVA SAID.

IT ADDED THAT THE FORTHCOMING CENTRAL COMMITTEE PLENUM WOULD BE INFORMED "ABOUT THE RESULTS OF THE TALKS OF THE PARTY AND GOVERNMENT DELEGATION IN MOSCOW, ABOUT THE CURRENT POLITICAL SITUATION IN SLOVAKIA; THE PLENUM WILL FURTHER DISCUSS THE DRAFT CONCERNING THE FEDERALIZATION OF THE REPUBLIC AND SOME CADRE (PERSONNEL) QUESTIONS".

THE PRESIDUM ALSO ACKNOWLEDGED A REPORT BY ITS MEMBER, ROBERT HARENCAR, SAYING THAT "YOUTHS ARE SUPPORTING THE CURRENT PARTY POLICY AND THAT MANY YOUNG PEOPLE ARE NOW JOINING THE PARTY", THE RADIO REPORTED.
