

X/4 C/S -- MOSCOW: STILL PROVOCATIVE PROPAGANDA IN PRAGUE

MUNICH, SEPT 4 (CMD) -- RADIO MOSCOW SAID TODAY THAT A NUMBER OF NEWSPAPERS IN PRAGUE ARE STILL PUBLISHING ANTI-SOCIALIST AND ANTI-SOVIET ARTICLES, AND HAVE NOT RPT NOT STOPPED PROVOCATIVE PROPAGANDA AGAINST THE RESULTS OF THE MOSCOW TALKS.

THE RADIO ALSO SAID "THE SITUATION IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA IS GRADUALLY BECOMING NORMAL." A NUMBER OF MEASURES TAKEN IN THE LAST FEW DAYS BY THE CZECHOSLOVAK CENTRAL COMMITTEE AND THE GOVERNMENT ARE CONTRIBUTING TO SUCH A DEVELOPMENT, IT ADDED.

REFERRING TO WHAT IT CALLED THE INSTRUCTION OF THE GOVERNMENT TO LOCAL AUTHORITEIS TO CONTACT ALLIED TROOPS COMMAND "FOR THE SOLUTION OF CURRENT PROBLEMS," RADIO MOSCOW SAID:

"AS SHOWN IN THE PRESS ORGANS, SUCH CONTACTS ARE BECOMING MORE AND MORE MULTIFORM. THEY CONCERN BOTH THE MAINTENANCE OF PUBLIC ORDER AND FRIENDLY ASSISTANCE BY ALLIED-TROOPS TO LOCAL POPULATION IN SOME PRACTICAL LIFE PROBLEMS.

"COMMON SENSE AND A REALISTIC APPROACH ARE GRADUALLY PREVAILING IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA, AND FACTS WHICH CONFIRM THAT THE LIFE IN THE COUNTRY IS TAKING ITS USUAL COURSE SERVE AS A PROOF OF THIS," RADIO MOSCOW ADDED.

THE RADIO THEN SAID: "HOWEVER, JUDGING BY EVERYTHING, THE NORMALIZATION OF THE SITUATION IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA IS NOT RPT NOT TAKEN INTO ACCOUNT BY THOSE WHO TRY TO ENCOURAGE COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARY FORCES.

"THIS CAN BE SEEN IN THE ARTICLES OF A NUMBER OF NEWSPAPERS AND JOURNALS PUBLISHED IN PRAGUE, WHICH UP TO NOW HAVE BEEN PUBLISHING MATERIALS WITH ANTI-SOCIALIST AND ANTI-SOVIET SUBSTANCE, WITHOUT STOPPING THEIR PROVOCATIVE PROPAGANDA AGAINST THE RESULTS OF THE SOVIET-CZECHOSLOVAK TALKS IN MOSCOW," RADIO MOSCOW SAID.
