X/13 C/S -- BOOKS ON CZECHOSLOVAKIA PLANNED

MUNICH, SEP 4 (GND/DPA)-- A WEST GERMAN PUBLISHING HOUSE, THE SUHRKAMP VERLAG OF FRANKFURT, PLANS TO BRING OUT TWO VOLUMES OF IMPORTANT CZECHOSLOVAK SPEECHES AND ARTICLES.

THE FIRST -- "SPEECHES TO THE FOURTH CONGRESS OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK WRITERS UNION, PRAGUE 1967" -- IS TO BE READY IN TIME FOR THE FRANKFURT BOOK FAIR, WHICH OPENS ON SEP 19.

THE SECOND VOLUME WILL CONTAIN IMPORTANT ARTICLES FROM THE WRITERS UNION JOURNAL LITERARNI LISTY WHICH APPEARED BETWEEN MAY AND AUGUST THIS YEAR. AMONG THEM WILL BE THE "MANIFESTO OF 2,000 WORDS".

ANOTHER WEST GERMAN PUBLISHER, THE ROMBACH VERLAG OF FREIBURG, WILL PUBLISH A VOLUME OF ARTICLES, SPEECHES AND COMMENTARIES BY PROFESSOR IVAN SVITAK UNDER THE TITLE "FORBIDDEN HORIZONS -- PRAGUE BETWEEN TWO WINTERS."

THE KIEPENHAUER AND WITSCH VERLAG OF COLOGNE WILL PUBLISH ON OCT 15 A BOOK ABOUT THE CZECHOSLOVAK REFORMED COMMUNISM AND THE OCCUPATION OF THE COUNTRY. THE AUTHORS ARE CHRISTIAN SCHMIDT-HAEUER, WHO WAS A CORRESPONDENT IN PRAGUE FOR MANY WEEKS, AND ADOLPH MUELLER, A CZECHOSLOVAK POLITICAL SCIENTIST. IT WILL BE CALLED "VIVA DUBCEK -- REFORM AND OCCUPATION IN THE CSSR."
