X/4 C/S -- SMRKOVSKY: PARLIAMENT PROGRAM TO BE CHANGED

MUNICH, SEP 4 (CMD )-- THE CHAIRMAN OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK PARLIAMENT, JOSEF SMKROVSKY SAID TODAY THE "ORIGINAL PROGRAM OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY SET FOR SEPTEMBER IS BEING CHANGED IN SUCH A WAY ... THAT WE START TO FULFILL RESPONSIBLY THE OBLIGATIONS ARISING FROM MOSCOW."

ACCORDING TO RADIO PRAGUE, SMRKOVSKY TODAY WROTE IN THE CZECHOSLOVAK PARTY DAILY RUDE PRAVO THAT THIS "IS AN INEVITABLE MEASURE AND THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY WILL AT THE SAME TIME ENSURE IN RESPECT TO ITS RIGHTS AND POWERS THAT THE INEVITABLE CHANGES AND THE ENTIRE NORMALIZATION OF LIFE TAKE PLACE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PRINCIPLES OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK LEGALITY."

RADIO PRAGUE SAID SMRKOVSKY "ASKS THE PUBLIC FOR UNDERSTANDING OF THIS INEVITABLE MATTER" WITH THE REFERENCE TO THE FACT THAT CONDITIONS ARE DEPENDING "ON THE FULFILLMENT OF THE INDIVIDUAL PARAGRAPHS OF THE MOSCOW DECISIONS BY OUR SIDE, HOWEVER, ALSO THE OTHER PARTNERS SHOULD ACT IN ACCORDANCE WITH US."

(CMD)-- RADIO PRAGUE SAID LAST NIGHT THAT A PLENARY SESSION OF THE PARLIAMENT WOULD TAKE PLACE "PROBABLY NEXT WEEK". THE RADIO ADDED THAT UNDOUBTEDLY THE PARLIAMENT WOULD DISCUSS THE MOST URGENT LAWS CONCERNING THE NATIONAL FRONT, SOME MEASURES IN THE SPHERE OF PRESS AND SOME OTHER COMMUNICATION MEDIA AND OTHER LAWS.

THE RADIO SAID TODAY THAT PARLIAMENTARY COMMITTEES ON AGRICULTURE AND NUTRITION BUILDING INVESTMENT AND CULTURE WOULD MEET THIS MONTH. THE CULTURAL COMMITTEE, IT SAID, WILL MOST PROBABLY DEAL WITH LEGAL CHANGES IN THE SPHERE OF COMMUNICATION MEDIA.
