X-13-WORLD 2ND ADD BRANDT: SOVIET INVASION (CN 93) XXX ERA

MR. BRANDT SAID THAT COUNTRIES SHOULD GIVE UP ""RECIPROCAL ACCUSATIONS"" AND SHOULD START TO WORK TOGETHER ON GENERAL AND CONTROLLED DISARMAMENT.

REPEATING HIS DEMAND OF YESTERDAY FOR A BASIC AND WORLDWIDE AGREEMENT TO RENOUNCE THE USE OF ALL FORCE -- NATO JUST NUCLEAR ARMS -- MR. BRANDT SAID THAT WEST GERMANY WAS PREPARED TO SUBMIT TO THE NON-NUCLEAR CONFERENCE A DRAFT TEXT OF A RESOLUTION OR A CONVENTION -- IF THE CONFERENCE DEVELOPMENTS PERMITTED IT.

HE SAID HIS USE OF THE TERM ""A EUROPEAN ZONE OF PEACEFUL NEIGHBORLINESS"" YESTERDAY , INSTEAD THE PHRASE ""ZONE OF DETENTE"" AS USED EARLIER, HAD NO MORE SIGNIFICANCE THAN BEING A MORE APT DESCRIPTION OF THE CONTENT OF THE PROPOSAL.

MR. BRANDT SAID THAT IN HIS SPEECH YESTERDAY HE DID NOT GO INTO MORE DETAILS ON SOVIET ATTEMPTS TO JUSTIFY THEIR INVASION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA BECAUSE HE FELT THAT THE MATTER WAS CLEAR.

""I DIDNT DEAL IN DETAILS BUT I WAS UNDER THE IMPRESSION THAT EVERYONE MUST HAVE UNDERSTOOD THE SUBJECT AS IT WAS DEALT WITH,"" HE SAID. ""I SAID THAT ON BEHALF OF MY GOVERNMENT WE DO NOT ACCEPT ANYONES CLAIM IN ANY INTERVENTION. WE WOULD NOT ACCEPT ANY PRINCIPLES OR RULES DIFFERING FROM THOSE USED IN NORMAL RELATIONS BETWEEN GOVERNMENT."
