

X/13 GDR -- EAST GERMAN PRESS NOTES "NORMALIZATION" IN CSSR  
BERLIN, SEPT 4 (RFE SPECIAL/WULFF) -- EAST GERMANY'S MAJOR  
NEWSPAPERS TODAY PLACED ALMOST ALL REPORTS DEALING WITH CZECHO-  
SLOVAKIA ON THEIR INSIDE PAGES WHILE FRONT-PAGE SPACE WAS GIVEN  
TO ONLY ONE REPORT ON THE CONTINUATION OF "NORMALIZATION" OF  
LIFE IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

THE OFFICIAL EAST GERMAN PARTY NEWSPAPER NEUES DEUTSCHLAND  
ON ITS FRONT-PAGE REPORT FROM PRAGUE SAID THAT BESIDES EFFORTS  
BY THE KPC TO FULFIL THE MOSCOW AGREEMENTS, IT BECAME MORE AND  
MORE OBVIOUS THAT THE "ANTI-SOCIALIST FORCES TRY ALL THEY CAN  
TO SABOTAGE ANY STEPS TAKEN BY THE LEVELHEADED PART OF THE POPULATION.  
TO NORMALIZE LIFE."

SIMILAR REPORTS APPEARED ON THE FRONT PAGES OF THE SEMI-OFFICIAL  
(EAST) BERLINER ZEITUNG AND THE ORGAN OF THE PRO-REGIME CHRISTIAN  
DEMOCRATIC PARTY NEUE ZEIT.

ON THEIR INSIDE PAGES NEUES DEUTSCHLAND AND BERLINER ZEITUNG  
CARRIED A REPORT, DATELINED MUNICH, WHICH SAID THE WEST GERMAN  
"SUEDDEUTSCHE ZEITUNG" HAD CALLED FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A CENTER  
OF "COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARY FORCES FROM CZECHOSLOVAKIA" WHICH HAD  
ESCAPED TO WEST GERMANY AND AUSTRIA.

IN THIS CONTEXT NEUES DEUTSCHLAND SAID THE WEST GERMAN PAPER  
HAD PUBLISHED A LIST WITH THE NAMES OF "THESE ANTI-SOCIALIST AND  
COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARY ELEMENTS" INCLUDING IVAN SVITAK, STANISLAW  
BUDIN, FORMER EDITOR-IN-CHIEF OF THE PERIODICAL "REPORTER," AND  
THE "LEADING" EDITORS OF "LITERARNY LISTY," MILAN JUNGMAHN,  
LUDVIK VESELY, IGOR HAJEK, IVAN STEIGER, PAVEL KOHOUT AND JOSEF  
SKVORECKY.

ALSO QUOTED BY NEUES DEUTSCHLAND AS LISTED IN THE SUEDDEUTSCHE  
ZEITUNG WERE "THE FOUNDER OF THE SO-CALLED FREE THEATER, JIRI  
VOSKOVEC, THE CHAIRMAN OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK JOURNALISTS'  
FEDERATION, PETR KETTNER, "THE FORMER EDITOR-IN-CHIEF OF THE PERIODI-  
CAL 'STUDENT', ALXEJ KUSAK," AND JIRINA PETRINOVA.
