X/13- E/W- LABOUR PERMITS FOR CZECHS AND SLOVAKS IN AUSTRIA

VIENNA, SEPT 4 (RFE SPECIAL/KOSTRBA)-- THE AUSTRIAN MINISTRY FOR SOCIAL CARE HAD ADVISED ALL AUSTRIAN LABOUR EXCHANGE OFFICES TO ISSUE AUTOMATICALLY SHORT-TERM LABOUR PERMITS TO ALL CZECHOSLOVAK APPLICANTS.

THE AUSTRIAN CENTRAL LABOUR OFFICE ANNOUNCED TO-DAY THAT 640 CZECHOSLOVAK NATIONALS LOOKING FOR A TEMPORARY JOB HAVE BEEN REGISTERED.

ABOUT 50 PER CENT OF THE REGISTERED CZECHOSLOVAK NATIONALS HAVE HIGHER EDUCATION AND THE MAJORITY ARE SPECIALISTS, TECHNICAL EXPERTS AND HIGHLY QUALIFIED WORKERS, THE ANNOUNCEMENT SAID.

ACCORDING TO THE AUSTRIAN CENTRAL LABOUR EXCHANGE, THE CZECHOSLOVAK APPLICANTS ARE WILLING TO ACCEPT EVEN UNQUALIFIED WORKERS JOBS. AUSTRIAN FIRMS INFORMED THE LABOUR EXCHANGE OFFICE OF THEIR "GENERAL SATISFACTION WITH THE QUALIFICATION AND HIGH WORKING MORAL OF THE CZECHS AND SLOVAKS".

THE DEMAND FOR CZECHOSLOVAK WORKERS IS INCREASING, THE CENTRAL LABOUR OFFICE ANNOUNCED.
