X/13 CURT - UNITA: BUDAPEST SAYS NO INVASION OF RUMANIA

ROME, SEPT. 4 -- (RFE SPECIAL) -- ITALYS COMMUNIST DAILY, UNITA, SAID TODAY IN A DISPATCH FROM BUDAPEST THAT THE HUNGARIAN FOREIGN MINISTRY HAD DENIED RUMANIA WAS IN DANGER OF INVASION.

THE PAPER SAID (FULL TEXT):

"AN OFFICIAL OF THE HUNGARIAN FOREIGN MINISTRY DECLARED THIS MORNING (SEPT 3) THAT THERE IS NO REASON FOR A MILITARY INTERVENTION IN RUMANIA, SINCE 'THE REGIME OF THIS COUNTRY IS NOT RPT NOT THREATENED.

"HUNGARY - HE ADDED - HAS NO REASON TO INTERFERE MILITARILY IN RUMANIA SINCE THE SOCIALIST REGIME HAS NOT RPT NOT BEEN PUT INTO DISCUSSION".
