

PRAGUE TV TO RESUME TONIGHT

MUNICH, SEPT. 4 (CMD)- RADIO PRAGUE ONE SAID TODAY THAT PRAGUE TELEVISION WOULD RESUME TELECASTS AT 2000 MT TONIGHT. IT ADDED THAT SIGNAL STRENGTH WOULD DEPEND ON THE CONDITION OF THE TRANSMITTERS AND RELAY STATIONS AND THAT PROBABLY RECEPTION WOULD BE POOR IN SOME AREAS.

THE PRAGUE TV STUDIO WAS VACATED BY OCCUPYING TROOPS LAST NIGHT, THE RADIO SAID. (RADIO PRAGUE ONE/F, 1215, SEPT 4)

RADIO BRATISLAVA SAID RADIO AND TELEVISION INSTALLATIONS IN KOSICE WERE TO BE VACATED AT 1800 MT TODAY. THE RADIO ADDED, HOWEVER, THAT THE TRANSMITTER HAD SUFFERED ARTILLERY DAMAGE AND NO RPT NO TRANSMISSIONS WERE EXPECTED IN THE FORESEEABLE FUTURE. (RADIO BRATISLAVA DOMESTIC, M, 1309, SEPT 4)

DIFFICULTIES IN START OF SCHOOLS

MUNICH, SEPT. 4 (CMD)- RADIO PRAGUE ONE SAID TODAY THE START OF THE SCHOOL YEAR HAD MET WITH "CERTAIN DIFFICULTIES."

THE RADIO SAID SOME TEACHERS WERE STILL ABROAD, SEVERAL GROUPS OF CHILDREN WERE STILL IN BULGARIA AND YUGOSLAVIA AND ABOUT 10,000 SCHOOL CHILDREN WERE STILL ON HOP-PICKING WORK.

"IN VIEW OF THE EXCEPTIONAL SITUATION, REPAIRS AND MAINTENANCE WORK HAVE NOT RPT NOT BEEN CARRIED OUT IN SOME OF THE SCHOOLS," THE RADIO SAID. (RADIO PRAGUE ONE/F, 0900, SEPT 4)

INTERNATIONAL ONCOLOGIST CONGRESS CANCELED

MUNICH, SEPT. 4 (CMD)- THE INTERNATIONAL CONGRESS OF ONCOLOGISTS (CMD: ONCOLOGY IS THE STUDY OF TUMORS), WHICH WAS TO BE HELD IN SMOLENICE (WESTERN SLOVAKIA) BETWEEN SEPT 16 AND 21, HAS BEEN CANCELED, RADIO BRATISLAVA SAID TODAY.

OCCUPATION DAMAGE

MUNICH, SEPT. 4 (CMD)- RADIO PRAGUE SAID TODAY THE FINANCE MINISTRY HAD SET UP A SPECIAL COMMISSION TO "DEAL WITH DAMAGE CAUSED BY THE ARRIVAL OF THE WARSAW PACT FORCES."

THE RADIO SAID THAT AFTER MATERIAL DAMAGE HAD BEEN CALCULATED, THE CZECHOSLOVAK GOVERNMENT WOULD NEGOTIATE INDEMNIFICATION WITH THE FIVE COUNTRIES INVOLVED.

THE RADIO SAID THE DAMAGE FIGURE COULD NOT RPT NOT BE FINALLY FIXED UNTIL THE FOREIGN TROOPS HAD LEFT. IT ADDED THAT TRANSPORT DAMAGE HAD PROVISIONALLY BEEN ESTIMATED AT ABOUT FIVE BILLION CROWNS. (RADIO PRAGUE ONE/F, 1215, SEPT 4)

MEANWHILE, RADIO BRATISLAVA SAID ROAD DAMAGE IN WEST SLOVAKIA HAD BEEN ESTIMATED AT 200 MILLION CROWNS.

THE RADIO ALSO SAID THAT COMMEMORATIVE PLACES ARE TO BE UNVEILED SATURDAY IN BRATISLAVA TO MARK THE PLACES WHERE FOUR CITIZENS "TRAGICALLY LOST THEIR LIVES." (RADIO BRATISLAVA/F, 1004, SEPT 4)

INTERIOR MINISTRY COMMUNISTS LAUD PAVEL

MUNICH, SEPT 4 (CMD)- THE PRESIDUM OF THE COMMUNIST PARTY UNIT IN THE CZECHOSLOVAK MINISTRY OF INTERIOR HAS "ONCE AGAIN PAID HIGH TRIBUTE" TO FORMER INTERIOR MINISTER JOSEF PAVEL, ACCORDING TO RADIO BRATISLAVA.

THE RADIO SAID THE PRESIDUM STATED: "WE FULLY UNDERSTAND THE REASONS WHICH INDUCED COMRADE PAVEL TO OFFER HIS RESIGNATION. WE DECLARE THAT WE SHALL CONTINUE, AS IN THE PAST, TO BE GUIDED BY THE PARTY'S ACTION PROGRAM." (RADIO BRATISLAVA/F, 1004, SEPT 4)
