

X/13 W GER - KIESINGER DEPARTS TOMORROW FOR TURKEY, IRAN, AFGHANISTAN

BONN, SEPT 4 (RFE SPECIAL/MARSH) -- WEST GERMAN CHANCELLOR KURT GEORG KIESINGER TOMORROW DEPARTS BONN FOR A TEN-DAY VISIT TO TURKEY, IRAN AND AFGHANISTAN.

THE CHANCELLOR WILL FLY FROM THE COLOGNE-WAHN AIRPORT AT 0940 MT AND ARRIVE IN ANKARA AT 1400, WHERE HE WILL MEET WITH PREMIER DEMIREL AND OTHER MEMBERS OF THE TURKISH GOVERNMENT.

KIESINGER WILL LAY A WREATH AT THE ATATURK MAUSOLEUM AND VISIT THE HETHITER MUSEUM BEFORE LEAVING ANKARA FOR ISMIR ON SATURDAY. IN ISMIR HE WILL VISIT THE GERMAN PAVILION AT THE ISMIR INTERNATIONAL FAIR.

SUNDAY, KIESINGER VISITS BERGAMA BY AUTOMOBILE AND FLIES TO INSTANBUL.

MONDAY, SEPT. 9, THE CHANCELLOR FLIES TO TEHERAN WHERE TALKS WITH THE SHAH AND MINISTER PRESIDENT HOVEYDA ARE SCHEDULED.

A GOVERNMENT SPOKESMAN HERE SAID TODAY THAT THE CHANCELLORS VISIT TO IRAN HAD TAKEN ON A NEW ACCENT BECAUSE OF THE EARTHQUAKES IN THAT COUNTRY, AND THAT GERMAN ASSISTANCE TO THE TEHERAN GOVERNMENT WOULD BE DISCUSSED DURING THE VISIT.

(GERMANY HAS ALREADY PLEDGED 200 THOUSAND MARKS (50 THOUSAND DOLLARS) AND A NUMBER OF AMBULANCES AND OTHER MATERIAL TO ASSIST IN CARING FOR THE VICTIMS).

KIESINGER LEAVES TEHERAN FOR KABUL ON THURSDAY, SEPT. 12.

IN AFGHANISTAN HE WILL MEET WITH THE ACTING MINISTER PRESIDENT, DR. ALI POPAL, AND BE RECEIVED BY THE KING AND QUEEN.

THE CHANCELLOR RETURNS TO BONN ON SUNDAY, SEPT. 15.
