

HELP FOR CZECHOSLOVAKS IS BEING COORDINATED

LONDON SEPTEMBER 4--(RFE SPECIAL/HOOD)--REPRESENTATIVES OF 17 BRITISH VOLUNTARY ORGANIZATIONS MET AT THE HOME OFFICE (INTERIOR MINISTRY) HERE YESTERDAY WITH UNDER SECRETARY DAVID ENNALS IN AN EFFORT TO COORDINATE ASSISTANCE TO CZECHOSLOVAKS IN BRITAIN.

IT WAS THE SECOND MEETING CALLED BY ENNALS TO COORDINATE OFFERS OF EMPLOYMENT AND HOUSING RECEIVED BY THE VARIOUS GROUPS, AND HE SAID IMMIGRATION OFFICERS AT PORTS AND AIRPORTS HAVE BEEN GIVEN DATA ON VOLUNTARY SERVICES AVAILABLE AND INSTRUCTED TO PASS IT ON TO CZECHOSLOVAK ARRIVALS WHO APPEAR TO NEED HELP.

THE NATIONAL UNION OF STUDENTS IS SEEKING UNIVERSITY PLACES FOR 200 TO 300 CZECHOSLOVAK STUDENTS AND IS COMPLETING PLANS TO LAUNCH A SCHOLARSHIP FUND OF 700,000 TO ONE MILLION DOLLARS TO ASSIST THEM."

WAR MOBILISATION FILM IN YUGOSLAVIA

BELGRADE, SEPT. 4 (REUTER/UPI) - (YUGOSLAVS WILL SOON SEE A FILM TELLING THEM WHAT TO DO IN A CASE OF WAR MOBILIZATION, THE OFFICIAL NEWS GENCY TANJUG REPORTED TODAY.

THE FILM MADE BY ARMY FILM CREWS, WILL BE SHOWN IN MOVIE THEATERS THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY ON THE NATIONAL TELEVISION NETWORK, TANJUG, SAID.

TANJUG SAID THE AIM OF THE FILM WAS TO "INFORM CITIZENS ABOUT THEIR DUTIES AT THE MOMENT WHEN WAR MOBILIZATION IS ANNOUNCED."

THE FILM WAS MADE "AFTER 30 SUCCESSFULLY EXECUTED MOBILIZATION EXERCISES" IN BOSNIA-HERZCEGOVINA PROVINCE.

BRITAIN EXPERIENCES GOLD AND DOLLAR SLUMP

LONDON, SEPT 4, REUTER - BRITAIN'S GOLD AND DOLLAR RESERVES SLUMPED BY 28 MILLION STERLING (67.2 MILLION DOLLARS) TO 1,111 MILLION STERLING (2,666.4 MILLION DOLLARS) LAST MONTH, THE TREASURY (FINANCE MINISTRY) ANNOUNCED HERE TODAY.

BUT IT EXPLAINED THAT 47 MILLION STERLING (112.8 MILLION DOLLARS) HAD BEEN PAID OFF DEBTS IN AUGUST.

THE RESERVES TOTAL HAD PERKED UP BY 21 MILLION STERLING IN JULY AFTER TWO BAD MONTHS BUT TODAY'S FIGURE PUTS THE RESERVES AT THEIR LOWEST THIS YEAR, THOUGH WELL UP ON THE 985 MILLION STERLING (2,364 MILLION DOLLARS) OF A YEAR AGO.

STERLING IMPROVED SOMEWHAT ON THE FOREIGN EXCHANGE MARKET AFTER THE FIGURES WERE ISSUED TODAY. MANY DEALERS HAD EXPECTED A BIGGER FALL.

EGYPT DENIES THAT TUNISIA MUZZLED DURING TALKS

CAIRO, SEPT 4, REUTER-EGYPT TODAY DENIED THAT THE TUNISIAN DELEGATION WAS MUZZLED WHILE CRITICISING THE EGYPTIAN GOVERNMENT DURING A SESSION OF THE ARAB LEAGUE CONFERENCE WHICH ENDED ON TUESDAY.

THE TUNISIAN DELEGATE WALKED OUT OF THE CONFERENCE HALL HERE LAST MONDAY AFTER ACCUSING EGYPT OF MAJOR RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE JUNE WAR IN THE MIDDLE EAST AND OF TRYING TO DOMINATE THE ARAB WORLD.
