X/4 C/S - SOUTH MORAVIAN HIGHWAY DAMAGE ASSESSED

MUNICH, AUG 4 (CMD) - THE TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT OF THE SOUTH MORAVIAN REGIONAL NATIONAL COMMITTEE HAS ESTIMATED THAT ROAD DAMAGE IN THE AREA RESULTING FROM FOREIGN WARSAW PACT TROOP MOVEMENTS TOTAL 78 MILLION KORUNAS.

THE SOUTH MORAVIAN ASSESSMENT WAS REPORTED BY RADIO CZECHOSLOVAKIA'S BRNO STUDIO.

IT SAID THAT THE REGIONAL TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT DID NOT RPT NOT INCLUDE DAMAGE TO CONCRETE OR PAVED ROADWAYS DUE TO EXCESSIVE ABRASION IN ITS ESTIMATE.

AN IMMEDIATE EXPENDITURE OF 33-MILLION KORUNAS WAS REQUIRED IN THE REGION, THE COMMITTEE DEPARTMENT SAID, TO MAKE ROADS USABLE AGAIN.

ENTERPRISES CONTROLLED BY NATIONAL COMMITTEES, RADIO CZECHOSLOVAKIA'S BRNO STUDIO SAID, HAD SUSTAINED PRODUCTION LOSSES OF CLOSE TO 60-MILLION KORUNAS. THERE WAS ALSO "A DEFICIENCY IN GROSS INCOME OF JUST UNDER 30-MILLION KORUNAS." (RADIO CZECHOSLOVAKIA, BRNO STUDIO / F, SEPT 4, 1732)
