

X/4 C/S - INVADERS WERE TAUGHT POWER OF CS UNITY, YUGOSLAV PAPER SAYS
BELGRADE, SEPT 4 (CMD) -- A YUGOSLAV PAPER SAID TODAY

THAT THE CZECHOSLOVAK PEOPLE HAD GIVEN INVADING FORCES "A TURE
LECTURE" ON THE POWER OF NATIONAL "UNITY AND SOLIDARITY OF THE
WORKING PEOPLE IN THE DEFENSE OF THEIR FREEDOM AND THEIR RIGHT TO
SOCIALISM."

THIS POWER HAD BEEN DEMONSTRATED, MEDJUNARODNA POLITIKA
WROTE, IN THE FACE OF "POLICE, PSYCHOLOGICAL AND OTHER KINDS OF
PRESSURE."

THE PAPER, DESCRIBED BY TANJUG AS A FOREIGN
AFFAIRS REVIEW, ALSO SAID THAT "THE BASIC STRATEGIC PLAN OF THE
INVADERS OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA HAD SERIOUSLY FAILED."

THE OCCUPATION POWERS "ASSUMPTION" THAT THE MERE "PRESENCE"
OF THEIR TANKS WOULD "BE SUFFICIENT FOR THE CONSERVATIVE FORCES
TO TAKE OVER, HAS NOT BEEN REALIZED, JUST AS SOVIET REPRESENTATIVES
TO THE MOSCOW TALKS WERE FORCED TO GIVE UP THEIR MAXIMUM PLAN, I.E.
TO HAVE THE BUREAUCRATIC-CONSERVATIVE REGIME RESTORED IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA
WITHOUT" DEALY.

MEDJUNARODNA POLITIKA ALSO EXPRESSED THE VIEW" THAT THE
UNITY OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK PEOPLE WILL CONTINUE TO BE A FACTOR ON
WHICH THE FATE OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA AND THAT OF CZECHOSLOVAK SOCIALISM
DEPEND THE MOST."

AT THE SAME TIME, THE NEWSPAPER SAID THAT THE "SITUATION
IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA IS A VERY COMPLEX ONE" AND THAT CZECHOSLOVAKS AND
THEIR LEADERS "WILL BE FACED WITH MANY TRIALS," SOME WHICH CAN BE
ANTICIPATED, OTHERS THAT "MAY COME UP UNEXPECTEDLYMZ

THE PAPER EXPRESSED THE VIEW" THAT THOSE WHO HAVE COMMITTED
THIS ATTACK, UNPRECEDENTED IN THE HISTORY OF SOCIALISM, WILL DRAW
FROM ALL THIS DEFINITE CONSEQUENCES AND THAT THEY WILL REALIZE THAT
SOCIALISM DOES NOT REST ON CANNON BARRESLT."
