X/4 C/S -- TOPICS OF SLOVAK CENTRAL COMMITTEE MEETING TOMORROW

MUNICH, AUG 4 (CMD) -- RADIO CZECHOSLOVAKIA SAID IN AN ENGLISH LANGUAGE TRANSMISSION TONIGHT THAT THE SLOVAK CENTRAL COMMITTEE WOULD DISCUSS THE RESULTS OF THE RECENT MOSCOW TALKS, THE PRESENT POLITICAL SITUATION IN SLOVAKIA AND PREPARATIONS FOR CZECHOSLOVAKIA'S FUTURE FEDERAL SETUP AT ITS MEETING TOMORROW.

THE RADIO SAID THAT THE SLOVAK PARTY PRESIDUM HAD MET IN BRATISLAVA YESTERDAY UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF FIRST SECRETARY GUSTAV HUSAK, WHO HAD DENIED THAT "A NUMBER OF ARRESTS HAD BEEN MADE IN SLOVAKIA."

THE PRESIDUM HAD BEEN TOLD BY ONE OF ITS SECRETARIES THAT "SLOVAK JOURNALISTS HAVE TAKEN A RESPONSIBLE APPROACH TO THEIR TASKS CONCERNING THE PRESENT POLITICAL PROBLEMS."

TO THIS END, NEWSPAPERS AND RADIO AND TELEVISION STATIONS HAD DECIDED TO "APPOINT EDITORS WHO WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR SELF-CENSORSHIP OF ALL PRINTED AND BROADCAST MATERIAL."

THE PRESIDUM HAD, RADIO CZECHOSLOVAKIA SAID, "NOTED THAT THE SLOVAK NATIONAL COUNCIL HAS SET UP A COMMISSION RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL TALKS WITH THE WARSAW PACT UNITS COMMAND IN SLOVAKIA."
