

X/4/9 C/S - WARSAW ATTACKS CZECHOSLOVAK PAPERS

MUNICH, SEPTEMBER 4 (CMD)- RADIO WARSAW TODAY ATTACKED SEVERAL CZECHOSLOVAK PAPERS AND TWO CZECHOSLOVAK WRITERS.

A RADIO BROADCAST FOR YOUNG PEOPLE SAID THAT THE FOLLOWING CZECHOSLOVAK PAPERS WERE LEADING IN THE ANTI-POLISH CAMPAIGN: THE WEEKLY OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK YOUTH FEDERATION, STUDENT, THE PAPER OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK JOURNALISTS, REPORTER, THE CZECH TRADE UNION PAPER, PRACE, THE WEEKLY OF CZECHOSLOVAK WRITERS, LITERARNI LISTY, THE WEEKLY OF THE UNION OF SLOVAK WRITERS, KULTURNI ZIVOT, THE DAILY OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK YOUTH FEDERATION, MLADA FRONTA, THE DAILY OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK PEOPLE'S PARTY, LIDOVA DEMOKRACIE, THE DAILY OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK SOCIALIST PARTY, SVOBODNE SLOVO, AND THE AGRICULTURAL PAPER, ZEMEDELSKE NOVINY.

THE RADIO SAID THAT UP TO NOW IT HAD NOT QUOTED ANY "ANTI-POLISH EXCESSES" BY CZECHOSLOVAK JOURNALISTS, BECAUSE THERE WAS HOPE THAT THE TALKS BETWEEN THE PARTY AND STATE LEADERS OF "THE FRATERNAL SOCIALIST COUNTRIES" WOULD RESULT IN A CESSATION OF THE "ANTI-SOCIALIST COUNTRIES" WOULD RESULT IN A CESSATION OF THE "ANTI-SOCIALIST AND ANTI-POLISH CAMPAIGN." THE BROADCAST SAID THAT IT ALSO DID NOT QUOTE THESE "EXCESSES" IN ORDER NOT TO INFLAME MUTUAL RELATIONS, AND TO AVOID THE ACCUSATION OF INTERFERING IN THE FREEDOM OF THE WORD IN THE FRATERNAL COUNTRY."

THE BROADCAST ATTACKED THE CZECHOSLOVAK WRITER, ARNOLD LUSTIG, FOR RADIO AND TELEVISION TALKS GIVEN IN MAY THIS YEAR AFTER HIS RETURN FROM ISRAEL.

THE RADIO ALSO ATTACKED LADISLAV MNACKO FOR HIS "SLANDERS" OF POLAND PRINTED IN KULTURNI ZIVOT IN THE JULY 19 ISSUE.
