EURO - CYPRUS, GREECE CONDEMN INTERVENTION

ATHENS, SEPT 4 (UPI/CNR)- GREECE AND CYPRUS TODAY CONDEMNED "INTERVENTION BY THIRD PARTIES IN THE INTERNAL AFFAIRS OF MEMBERS OF THE UNITED NATIONS."

A JOINT COMMUNIQUE SAID ALSO GREECE AND CYPRUS "AFFIRMED THE DANGERS CAUSED BY THE USE OR THREAT OF FORCE IN INTERNATIONAL DIFFERENCES."

THE COMMUNIQUE WAS ISSUED AFTER TALKS BETWEEN CYPRUS PRESIDENT ARCHBISHOP MAKARIOS AND GREEK GOVERNMENT LEADERS IN ATHENS.

THE COMMUNIQUE SAID MAKARIOS AND GREEK LEADERS CALLED FOR THE RETORATION OF COMPLETE CALM IN CYPRUS AND EXPRESSED HOPE THAT AGREEMENT WILL BE REACHED WITH TURKISH CYPRIOT LEADERS.

THE TWO SIDES AGREED TO KEEP IN CLOSE CONTACT ON ALL ASPECTS OF THE CYPRUS PROBLEM, THE COMMUNIQUE SAID.

MAKARIOS ARRIVED IN ATHENS MONDAY ON AN OFFICIAL VISIT.

THE COMMUNIQUE SAID THE VISIT PROVIDED AN OPORTUNITY TO REAFFIRM THE "FULL IDENTITY OF VIEWS BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENTS OF GREECE AND CYPRUS."
