

## WORLD - SHORTER ITEMS

W. GERMANY SNUBS EASTERN/SOME DIPLOMATS

GENEVA, SEPT. 4, REUTER -- WEST GERMANY TONIGHT SNUBBED THE SOVIET UNION AND THREE OF ITS ALLIES BY NOT INVITING THEM TO A DIPLOMATIC RECEPTION GIVEN BY FOREIGN MINISTER WILLY BRANDT.

RUMANIAN FIRST DEPUTY FOREIGN MINISTER GHEORGHE MACOVESCO AND CZECHOSLOVAK DIPLOMATS WERE AT THE RECEPTION, BUT SOVIET, POLISH, HUNGARIAN AND BULGARIAN DIPLOMATS WERE NOT INVITED.

A SENIOR WEST GERMAN OFFICIAL COMMENTED THAT "WE COULD NOT INVITE THE INTERVENTIONISTS."

THE RECEPTION WAS HELD FOR DELEGATES TO THE 94-NATION CONFERENCE OF NON-NUCLEAR STATES HERE.

CHICAGO CONVENTION VIOLENCE INVESTIGATION

WASHINGTON, SEPT. 4, REUTER - A PRESIDENTIAL COMMISSION STUDYING VIOLENCE IN THE UNITED STATES TODAY DECIDED TO INVESTIGATE THE "SERIOUS AND MASS VIOLENCE" DURING THE DEMOCRATIC PARTYS NATIONAL CONVENTION IN CHICAGO LAST WEEK.

DR. MILTON S. EISENHOWER, CHAIRMAN OF THE NATIONAL COMMISSION ON THE CAUSES AND PREVENTION OF VIOLENCE, SAID A SPECIAL TASK FORCE WOULD INVESTIGATE ALL ASPECTS OF THE CHICAGO CLASHES.

HE SAID THE GROUP WOULD ALSO LOOK INTO GUN BATTLES IN CLEVELAND IN JULY BETWEEN POLICE AND BLACK MILITANTS AND MIGHT INVESTIGATE THE RIOTING IN NEGRO AREAS OF MIAMI DURING THE REPUBLICAN NATIONAL CONVENTION.

DR. EISENHOWER IS THE BROTHER OF FORMER PRESIDENT DWIGHT D. EISENHOWER.

THE COMMISSION WAS SET UP BY PRESIDENT JOHNSON AFTER THE ASSASSINATION OF SENATOR ROBERT F. KENNEDY IN LOS ANGELES IN JUNE.

IT WAS CHARGED WITH STUDYING THE CAUSES OF POLITICAL, RACIAL AND OTHER MAJOR VIOLENCE IN AMERICA AND MAKING RECOMMENDATIONS FOR PREVENTING FUTURE OUTBREAKS.

IZVESTIA ATTACKS JOHNSON

MOSCOW, SEPT 4 (REUTER) - THE SOVIET GOVERNMENT NEWSPAPER, IZVESTIA, ACCUSED PRESIDENT JOHNSON TODAY OF CRUSHING "TIMID, DOVISH GESTURES" ON VIETNAM MADE BY MR. HUBERT HUMPHREY, THE DEMOCRATIC PARTYS PRESIDENTIAL NOMINEE.

A COMMENTARY IN THE NEWSPAPER SAID PRESIDENT JOHNSON HAD ALSO DICTATED THE VIETNAM PLATFORM ADOPTED BY THE DEMOCRATIC PARTY CONVENTION, WHICH HAD REAFFIRMED THE PRESIDENT'S OWN POLICIES.

IN PASSING THE "CUP OF POWER" TO OTHERS, PRESIDENT JOHNSON WAS DICTATING HIS POLICIES TO THEM, IZVESTIA SAID. THESE POLICIES WERE BEING ACCEPTED BY BOTH MR. HUMPHREY AND HIS REPUBLICAN PARTY OPPONENT, MR. RICHARD NIXON.

ISRAEL HOLDS TWO U.A.R. FISHING BOATS (W/SUMMARY)

JERUSALEM, SEPT 4 (UPI) - AN ISRAELI SPOKESMAN SAID TODAY TWO EGYPTIAN FISHING BOATS WHICH PENETRATED AN "ISRAELI CONTROLLED AREA" NEAR THE SHORES OF THE SINAI PENINSULA LAST THURSDAY HAD BEEN DETAINED BY THE ISRAELIS.

THERE WERE 16 EGYPTIAN FISHERMEN ABOARD THE BOATS.

THE INCIDENT TOOK PLACE IN THE BRADAMILLE SECTOR NEAR THE MEDITERRANEAN SEA, THE SPOKESMAN SAID.
