X/4 C/S - MEMORIAL TABLETS IN BRATISLAVA FOR THOSE KILLED

MUNICH, SEPT 5 (CMD) - THE COUNCIL OF THE BRATISLAVA CITY NATIONAL COMMITTEE HAS DECIDED TO MARK BY MEMORIAL TABLETS THE PLACES WHERE "OUR YOUNG CITIZENS LOST THEIR LIVES DURING THE RECENT 14 DAYS," RADIO BRATISLAVA REPORTED LAST NIGHT.

THE RADIO SAID THE MEMORIAL TABLETS WILL BE PLACED AT THE BRATISLAVA UNIVERSITY AND ON THE BUILDING OF THE GENERAL POST OFFICE.

THE RADIO SAID "ON THESE SYMBOLS THERE WILL BE THE NAMES OF KILLED MARGITA KOSANOVA, STANISLAV SIVAK, CAPTAIN JAN HOLIK AND PETER LEGNER, WHICH WILL REMIND US AND THE FUTURE GENERATIONS OF THE SAD EVENTS OF THIS PERIOD."

THE RADIO SAID SCULPTOR CTIBOR VATCHAI AND GRAPHIC ARTIST ANTON HOLY WILL NOT RPT NOT ASK FOR A FINANCIAL REWARD FOR THEIR WORK ON THE TABLETS WHICH WILL BE PLACED PROBABLY ON SATURDAY OF THIS WEEK.
