

CZECHOSLOVAKS NOT RPT NOT ALLOWED TO TRAVEL VIA HUNGARY
MUNICH, SEPT 5 (CMD)-THE HUNGARIAN BORDER GUARDS AT THE SOUTH
SLOVAK-HUNGARIAN RAILWAY CROSSING POINT STUROVO "CONTINUE TO
PREVENT" CZECHOSLOVAKS FROM TRAVELLING VIA HUNGARY TERRITORY, RADIO
BRATISLAVA REPORTED LAST NIGHT.

THE RADIO SAID THAT ACCORDING TO INFORMATION FROM THE CHIEF OF THE
ADMINISTRATION OF THE EAST SLOVAK RAILWAYS, STEFAN SUTEK, BOTH GOODS
AND PASSENGER RAILWAY TRANSPORT HAS BEEN BASICALLY NORMALIZED."

THE RADIO SAID THAT IN ZVOLEN AND POPRAD THE UNLOADING "OF TRAINS
"IS LAGGING BEHIND," AND THAT IN THE RAILWAY STATION STUROVO, HUNGARIAN
BORDER GUARDS CONTINUE TO PREVENT OUR PASSENGERS FROM TRAVELLING VIA
HUNGARIAN TERRITORY.

HEART TRANSPLANTED IN OHIO

CLEVELAND, SEPT 5 (UPI)-THE HEART OF A 25-YEAR-OLD WOMAN FATAL-
LY INJURED IN A TRAFFIC ACCIDENT WAS TRANSPLANTED INTO THE CHEST
OF AN AKRON, OHIO, MAN AT THE CLEVELAND CLINIC WEDNESDAY.

A CLINIC SPOKESMAN SAID THE RECIPIENT, DELLETT H. LAWSON, 50,
WAS IN SATISFACTORY CONDITION. THE DONOR WAS IDENTIFIED AS
MRS. BARBARA SMITH OF WALNUT RIDGE, ARKANSAS, WHO DIED WEDNESDAY.

THE HEART TRANSPLANT WAS BELIEVED TO BE THE FIRST IN OHIO.

MRS. SMITH'S PARENTS WERE REPORTED TO HAVE GIVEN PERMISSION
TO USE HER HEART AND ALSO HER KIDNEYS IN A SUBSEQUENT TRANSPLANT.

FOUR SURGEONS, SIX NURSES AND FOUR MEDICAL TECHNICIANS
TOOK PART IN THE 2-1/2 HOUR OPERATION. DETAILS OF THE OPERATION
AND NAMES OF THE MEDICAL TEAM WERE NOT RELEASED.

SIMULATED MOONSHIP LAUNCH SUCCESSFUL

CAPE KENNEDY, FLORIDA, SEPT. 4, REUTER--THREE ASTRONAUTS WEDNESDAY
WENT THROUGH A DRESS REHEARSAL FOR THE FIRST MANNED APOLLO LAUNCH
NOW SCHEDULED FOR OCTOBER 11.

IN A SIMILAR REHEARSAL LAST YEAR, THREE ASTRONAUTS WERE BURNED
TO DEATH. SINCE THEN, MANY MILLIONS OF DOLLARS HAVE BEEN SPENT ON
FIREPROOFING THE SPACECRAFT AND ADDING MORE SAFETY EQUIPMENT TO
THE LAUNCH PAD.

IN THE REHEARSAL, CREW MEMBERS WALTER SCHIRRA, DONN
EISELE AND WALTER CUNNINGHAM, WHO ARE TO MAKE THE FLIGHT, CHECKED
VARIOUS PHASES OF FLIGHT PROCEDURE AFTER LIFT-OFF.

THE SPACECRAFT WAS NOT PRESSURISED NOR DID IT CONTAIN
PURE OXYGEN. THE CREW WORE SPORTS CLOTHES INSTEAD OF THEIR SPACE
SUITS.

ASTRONAUTS VIRGIL GRISSOM, EDWARD WHITE AND ROGER CHAFFEE DIED
ON JANUARY 27, LAST YEAR, WHEN FIRE SWEEPED THROUGH THEIR PRESSURISED
APOLLO SPACECRAFT FILLED WITH PURE OXYGEN. THEY COULD NOT OPEN
THE HATCH IN TIME TO ESCAPE.
