WORLD -- THE DAY AHEAD

MUNICH, SEPT 5 (CNR)-THE SITUATIONS IN EASTERN EUROPE AND WESTERN AFRICA SHARE WORLD ATTENTION AND CONCERN TODAY.

SIGNS OF PROGRESS TOWARD A RETURN TO NORMAL LIFE IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA WERE REPORTED YESTERDAY, THOUGH THE OCCUPATION BY WARSAW PACT POWERS CONTINUED. ALSO CONTINUING WERE POLEMICS IN THE COMMUNIST PRESS, BOTH WITHIN AND OUTSIDE THE SOVIET BLOC.

IN AFRICA, DEVELOPMENTS ARE AWAITED IN THE COUP D'ETAT REPORTED TO HAVE OUSTED PRESIDENT ALPHONSE MASSEMBA-DEBAT OF THE FORMER FRENCH CONGO, IN THE NIGERIAN CIVIL WAR AND IN THE MEETING OF ORGANIZATION OF AFRICAN UNITY FOREIGN MINISTERS CONTINUING IN ALGIERS.

THE UNITED NATIONS SECURITY COUNCIL TODAY IS TO RESUME DEBATE ON AN ISRAELI CHARGE OF AGGRESSION BY THE UNITED ARAB REPUBLIC, DENIED BY THE U.A.R. AT A BRIEF SESSION WEDNESDAY.

THE CONFERENCE OF NON-NUCLEAR STATES IN GENEVA GOES BACK INTO PLENARY SESSION TODAY AFTER COMMITTEE MEETINGS WEDNESDAY AFTERNOON.

PRESIDENT JOHNSON IS TO LEAD A FULL-SCALE MEETING OF HIS CABINET TODAY, FOLLOWING LAST EVENING'S MEETING OF THE NATIONAL SECURITY COUNCIL.

CHANCELLOR KURT GEORG KIESINGER OF WEST GERMANY TODAY IS TO LEAVE BONN FOR A TEN-DAY TRIP WHICH IS TO TAKE HIM TO TURKEY, IRAN AND AFGHANISTAN.

ON THE LIGHTER SIDE TODAY, THE THEATRE DES ARTS IS THE FIRST PARIS THEATER TO OPEN THE WINTER SEASON WITH AN ENTIRELY NEW CREATION: JACK BELGER'S ALREADY FAMOUS "THE CONNECTION". THE PUBLIC DRESS REHEARSAL OF THIS JAZZ-AND-DRUG PLAY IS TONIGHT.

A PIANO RECITAL BY WILHELM KEMPF HEADS THE MUSICAL BILL IN SWITZERLAND. THE PIANIST WILL GIVE A BEETHOVEN CONCERT AT MONTREUX'S PAVILLON, STARTING AT 2030, AS PART OF THE MONTREUX 1968 MUSIC FESTIVAL.

MEANWHILE, GENEVA'S ZODIAQUE IS SHOWING (UNTIL SEPT 18) AN EXHIBITION OF 194 DRAWINGS BY GIORGIO DE CHIRICO. OPEN MONDAY TO FRIDAY FROM 1000 TO 1830 AND ON SATURDAY, 1000 TO 1700.
