US -- JOHNSON TO MEET WITH CABINET, U.S. AMBASSADOR TO MOSCOW

WASHINGTON, SEPT 5 (RFE SPECIAL/UPI/CNR)-PRESIDENT JOHNSON TODAY IS TO MEET WITH HIS CABINET AND WITH THE U.S. AMBASSADOR TO THE SOVIET UNION, LLEWELLYN THOMPSON, FOLLOWING A ONE-HOUR SESSION OF THE NATIONAL SECURITY COUNCIL WEDNESDAY.

THERE WAS NO WORD ON THE PROCEEDINGS OF THE NATIONAL SECURITY COUNCIL, THE ADMINISTRATION'S HIGHEST ADVISORY AND POLICY-MAKING BODY. THE WHITE HOUSE DESCRIBED THE MEETING ONLY AS "A GENERAL REVIEW OF VARIOUS WORLD TROUBLE SPOTS."

RADIO FREE EUROPE'S WASHINGTON CORRESPONDENT SAID THAT THE CZECHOSLOVAKIAN SITUATION CAME UNDER THIS CATEGORY.

SPOKESMEN DECLINED COMMENT ON THE NATURE OF THE MATTERS TO BE DISCUSSED BY THE CABINET OR ON THE REASONS FOR JOHNSON'S SCHEDULED PRIVATE MEETING WITH AMBASSADOR THOMPSON.
