X/4 C/S - SOFIA: ILLEGAL NETWORK STILL ACTIVE

MUNICH, SEPT 5 (CMD) - RADIO SOFIA QUOTED A BTA DISPATCH FROM PRAGUE LAST NIGHT AS SAYING THE "ILLEGAL NETWORK" FORCES IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA WERE STILL ACTIVE AND THAT THEY RECENTLY EXPLODED A BOMB IN FRONT OF THE CETEKA BUILDING IN PRAGUE.

THE DISPATCH SAID THAT ALL NEWS REPORTS IN PRAGUE SHOWED THAT "A PERSISTENT STRUGGLE IS BEING CONDUCTED FOR THE FINAL INTERRUPTION OF ALL ATTEMPTS AT ILLEGAL AND ANTI-SOCIALIST ACTIONS..."

AFTER REFERRING TO "CLOSE CONNECTIONS" BETWEEN FORMER DEPUTY PREMIER OTA SIK AND "FORCES THAT NOW SHOW THEIR TEETH EVERY DAY," THE DISPATCH SAID:

"YESTERDAY'S ALLEGED FIGHTERS FOR LEGALITY AND ORDER, FOR OBSERVING THE ORDERS OF THE LEGALLY ELECTED PARTY, STATE AND OTHER AGENCIES, NOW TRY TO CONDUCT AN ILLEGAL STRUGGLE PRECISELY AGAINST THE DECISIONS, THE LINE AND THE ORDERS OF THE LEGAL ORGANS."

THE DISPATCH ALSO MENTIONED LEAFLETS THAT WERE DISTRIBUTED DURING THE PAST TWO DAYS, AND WHICH SPEAK OF "THE ALLEGED SUBSTANCE OF SECRET MOSCOW PROTOCOLS." THE DISPATCH SAID THAT FOR ORGANIZING ILLEGAL PRINTING OF THOSE LEAFLETS AND THEIR DISSEMINATION, ONE MUST HAVE A WELL-CONCEALED AND ORGANIZED "ILLEGAL NETWORK."
