X/4 C/S - PILLER DESCRIBES PAST EVENTS

MUNICH, SEP 5 (CMD)-- RADIO PRAGUE REPORTS THAT THE SECRETARY OF THE CENTRAL BOHEMIAN COUNTY COMMUNIST PARTY COMMITTEE, JAN PILLER, DESCRIBED HIS "ACTIVITY IN THE PAST DAYS" IN TODAY'S EDITION OF THE CENTRAL BOHEMIAN COMMUNIST PARTY DAILY, SVOBODA.

ACCORDING TO THE RADIO, PILLER, WHO IS ALSO CZECHOSLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY PRESIDUM MEMBER, DEALS IN HIS ARTICLE WITH "THE SITUATION DURING THE TALKS OF THE SO-CALLED CENTRAL COMMITTEE OF ONE-THIRD OF THE PARTY IN THE HOTEL PRAHA AUG 22."

HE ALSO DESCRIBES THE CIRCUMSTANCES AROUND THE DEPARTURE "OF OUR DELEGATION TO MOSCOW."

DETAILS ON THIS WERE NOT RPT NOT GIVEN.

THE RADIO ALSO SAID:

"AS IS KNOWN THE CENTRAL BOHEMIAN COUNTY COMMITTEE OF THE COMMUNIST PARTY EXPRESSED ITS FULL CONFIDENCE IN RESPECT TO COMRADE PILLER IN THE PAST DAYS," THE RADIO ADDED.

"IT HAS ACKNOWLEDGED WITH SATISFACTION THE STATEMENT BY COMRADE (ALEXANDER ) DUBCEK THAT JAN PILLER BELONGS AMONG HIS FAITHFUL SUPPORTERS AND THAT HE FIRMLY SUPPORTED THE POSITIONS OF THE POST-JANUARY POLICY OF THE PARTY," THE RADIO SAID IN ITS REVIEW OF PILLER'S ARTICLE.
