

RAIL CONGRESS SWITCHES FROM PRAGUE TO BASEL

GENEVA, SEPT. 5 (RFE SPECIAL/MAHONEY) -- THE SWISS RAILROAD SYSTEM ANNOUNCED HERE TODAY THAT THE EUROPEAN CONFERENCE ON PASSENGER TRAIN SCHEDULES AND RAILCAR EXCHANGE HAS BEEN RE-SCHEDULED FROM PRAGUE TO BASEL AFTER CZECHOSLOVAKIA DECLARED ITSELF UNABLE TO HOLD THE MEETING BECAUSE OF THE POLITICAL SITUATION.

THE MEETING WILL BE HELD IN BASEL SEPT. 18 TO 24.
