X/4 C/S -- SOVIETS LEAVE CESKE BUDEJOVICE RADIO BUILDING

MUNICH, SEP 5 (CMD)-- RADIO PRAGUE REPORTS THAT THE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SOVIET ARMY HANDED OVER THE RADIO BUILDING IN CESKE BUDEJOVICE "TO THE HANDS OF OUR RADIO WORKERS" TODAY.

THE RADIO ADDED THAT THE HANDOVER TOOK PLACE IN PRESENCE OF THE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK ARMED FORCES, POLICE, AND OTHER INSTITUTIONS.

"FORTUNATELY THE BUILDING HAS NOT YET NOT SUFFERED ANY SERIOUS DAMAGE. HOWEVER, IT WILL TAKE PROBABLY A WHOLE DAY BEFORE THE EXPLOSIVES EXPERTS WILL CONCLUDE THEIR SEARCH AND THE GROUPS OF HEALTH EXPERTS CONCLUDE THEIR WORK AIMED AT BRINGING THE BUILDING INTO A NORMAL STATE," RADIO PRAGUE SAID.
