X/13/9 CS -- POLISH TV COMMENTATORS SEE CONTINUING OPPOSITION

BERLIN, SEPT 5 (RFE SPECIAL/SCHLEICH/CNR)) -- POLISH TELEVISION COMMENTATORS LAST NIGHT NOTED AN ATTITUDE OF NON-COMPLIANCE IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

CAPTAIN BOHDAN SWIATKIEWICZ, THE EDITOR OF THE TELEVISION PROGRAMS FOR THE POLISH ARMED FORCES, COMPLAINED ON THE "SWIATOWID" PROGRAM "HOW MANY PEOPLE HERE (IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA) DISCUSS POSSIBILITIES OF NOT RPT NOT COMPLYING WITH ORDERS AND HOW FERVENTLY THEY PLEAD FOR SUCH AN ATTITUDE ."

HE SAID IT TOOK "A GREAT DEAL OF SELF-CONTROL" TO PUT UP WITH MANY PROVOCATIVE GESTURES AND ADDED THAT "WE WILL HAVE TO DEAL WITH SUCH PROBLEMS FOR A LONG TIME TO COME."

COMMENTATOR ZYGMUNT BRONIAREK, A STAFF MEMBER OF TRYBUNA LUDU, WHO WAS SPEAKING ON THE SAME PROGRAM, NAMED PRESIDENT SVOBODA AND VICE-PREMIER HUSAK AS THOSE CZECHOSLOVAK LEADERS WHO WERE GIVING THE MOSCOW AGREEMENT THEIR LOYAL AND FAITHFUL SUPPORT.

AT THE SAME TIME, THE COMMENTATOR SPOKE OF A TREND AMONG CZECHOSLOVAK PARTY AND GOVERNMENT LEADERS TO MEET THE TERMS OF THE MOSCOW AGREEMENT "SO THAT THE FOREIGN TROOPS WILL LEAVE THE COUNTRY AND THUS MAKE IT POSSIBLE TO RETURN TO THE OLD CONDITIONS.
