C/S -- WARNING TO RED ARMY MEN

MOSCOW, SEP 5 (UPI)- SOVIET OCCUPATION TROOPS WERE TOLD TODAY TO BEWARE "YOUNGSTERS OF LOOSE MORALS" IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

THE ARMY NEWSPAPER KRASNAYA ZVEZDA (RED STAR) SAID SOME CZECH TEENAGERS, INSPIRED BY WESTERN PROPAGANDA, NOT ONLY WERE IMMORAL BUT ALSO LIKED "TO SHOOT FROM BEHIND THE CORNER" AT RUSSIAN SOLDIERS

"COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARIES AND WESTERN PROPAGANDISTS ARE BANKING ON THESE YOUNGSTERS WITH LOOSE MORALS," THE PAPER SAID.

IN A DISPATCH FROM BRATISLAVA, THE PAPER CLAIMED RUSSIAN TROOPS SHOWED "DISGUST" WHEN THEY SAW A YOUNG CZECHOSLOVAK KISSING HIS GIRL-FRIEND.

"HE WAS LONGHAIRE, WEARING SOME SORT OF RED TROUSERS AND SHE WAS NAKED UP TO THE EXTREME LIMITS," THE DISPATCH WRITTEN BY LT. COL. V. TRIHMANENKO SAID.

"THEY STARTED KISSING IN FRONT OF US ALL AS IF THEY WANTED TO SAY 'LOOK WHAT FREEDOM OF MORALS WE HAVE'," THE CORRESPONDENT SAID.

BUT SOVIET SOLDIERS WERE "SPITTING AS THEY WATCHED THIS SCENE WITH DISGUST," THE DISPATCH ADDED.
