

X/4 C/S -- HUSAK: JANUARY LINE -- A BASIS OF POLICY (RELEADS CN 67)

MUNICH, SEP 5 (CMD)-- SLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY LEADER GUSTAV HUSAK TOLD A PLENUM OF THE SLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE TODAY THAT THE GENERAL LINE ADOPTED IN JANUARY "CONTINUES TO BE THE BASIS OF OUR POLICY."

ACCORDING TO RADIO BRATISLAVA, HUSAK "INFORMED THE PARTICIPANTS IN THE PLENUM ABOUT THE CURRENT SITUATION; HE COMMENTED IN DETAIL ON THE MOSCOW AGREEMENTS AND HAS ASSUMED A STAND ON THE RESULTS OF THE EXTRAORDINARY CONGRESS OF THE COMMUNIST PARTY OF SLOVAKIA."

THE RADIO SAID: "HUSAK STRESSED THAT IN SLOVAKIA THE CONCLUSIONS OF OUR CONGRESS WERE RECEIVED WITH SATISFACTION AND THAT A CERTAIN DETENTE APPEARED IN SLOVAKIA AFTER THE PUBLICATION OF THE CONGRESS DOCUMENTS."

"HE ALSO SAID THAT OUR EXTRAORDINARY SITUATION HAS CONTRIBUTED TOWARD AN UNUSUAL UNITY OF THE PARTY AND STATE," RADIO BRATISLAVA REPORTED.

THE RADIO SAID HUSAK POINTED OUT THAT "WE STILL CONSIDER THE GENERAL LINE THAT WAS ADOPTED IN JANUARY AS THE BASIS FOR OUR POLICY.

"IN THE PRESENT PERIOD THE CONSOLIDATION OF ECONOMIC RELATIONS IS THE FIRST TASK," HE ADDED.

ACCORDING TO THE RADIO, HUSAK ALSO REACTED TO THE OPINION ASKING WHETHER NOW "IT IS NECESSARY TO SPEAK ABOUT FEDERALIZATION."

"HE STRESSED ", THE RADIO SAID", THAT IT IS NECESSARY TO PAY ATTENTION THAT THE FEDERALIZATION BE PROCLAIMED WITHIN THE SET DEADLINE ACCORDING TO THE AGREED UPON PRINCIPLES."
