PRAGUE NATIONAL COMMITTEE CALLS FOR NORMALIZATION  
MUNICH, SEPT. 5 (CMD)- THE PRAGUE NATIONAL COMMITTEE  
APPEALED TO ALL CZECHOSLOVAKS TODAY TO BRING ABOUT AN EARLY RETURN  
TO NORMAL CONDITIONS IN THE CAPITAL.

RADIO PRAGUE BROADCAST THE APPEAL, WHICH ALSO ASKED THAT ROADS  
SIGNS, STREET NAMES, AND HOUSE NUMBERS BE REPLACED OR RENEWED  
AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.

THE APPEAL SAID THAT THE ABSENCE OF THESE SIGNS INCREASED  
THE WORK OF MAILMEN AND CAUSED DIFFICULTIES FOR AMBULANCE CREWS  
AND DELIVERY DRIVERS. (RADIO PRAGUE IN CZECH/F, SEPT 5, 0700)

LONGO, CARRILLO AGREE ON CSR

ROME, SEPT. 5--(RFE SPECIAL/TEMPEST)---ITALIAN COMMUNIST LEADERS  
AND SECRETARY OF THE SPANISH COMMUNIST PARTY, SANTIAGO CARRILLO,  
HAVE AGREED IN ROME ON ASPECTS OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK PROBLEM, ACCORDING TO  
UNITA TODAY.

THE COMMUNIST PAPER SAID THERE WAS A "CONVERGENCE OF VIEWS ON  
ALL PROBLEMS, INCLUDING THE QUESTION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA," AFTER  
TALKS OVER THE PAST FEW DAYS BETWEEN THE SPANISH LEADER AND  
COMMUNIST LEADERS, INCLUDING PARTY SECRETARY LUIGI LONGO.

UNITA SAID CARRILLO AND THE ITALIAN COMMUNIST DISCUSSED THE  
INTERNATIONAL SITUATION IN AN "ATMOSPHERE OF FRATERNAL FRIENDSHIP."

CZECHOSLOVAKS WILL COMPETE IN MOTORCYCLE CUP FINAL

LONDON SEPTEMBER 5--(RFE SPECIAL/HOOD)--A SPEEDWAY CONTROL  
BOARD OFFICIAL SAID TODAY THAT THE CZECHOSLOVAK TEAM WILL  
DEFINITELY BE COMPETING IN THE WORLD TEAM CUP FINAL BEING  
HELD AT WEMBLEY STADIUM IN LONDON, SEPTEMBER 21.

THE COMPETING TEAMS IN THE FIRST CUP FINAL TO BE HELD  
IN ENGLAND ARE BRITAIN, SWEDEN AND POLAND AND CZECHOSLOVAKIA,  
WHO QUALIFIED FOR THE FINAL BY FINISHING ABOVE RUSSIA AND  
EAST GERMANY IN THE LAST ROUND OF THE COMPETITION.

"THERE HAVE BEEN PROTRACTED NEGOTIATIONS AT INTERNATIONAL  
LEVEL SINCE THE OCCUPATION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA," THE SPEEDWAY  
CONTROL BOARD OFFICIAL SAID, "BUT WE ARE NOW RPT NOW  
ASSURED THAT THE CZECHS WILL BE ABLE TO COME TO WEMBLEY."

SCANDINAVIAN DENTISTS BOYCOTT BULGARIAN CONGRESS

STOCKHOLM, SEPT 5 -- (RFE SPECIAL/HENRY) -- THE SWEDISH,  
DANISH AND NORWEGIAN NATIONAL ASSOCIATIONS OF DENTISTS WILL NOT  
ATTEND THE WORLD CONGRESS OF DENTISTS IN BULGARIA IN MID-SEPTEMBER  
DUE TO THE EVENTS IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

THE SWEDISH ASSOCIATION SAID ALL THREE SCANDINAVIAN GROUPS  
URGED THE CANCELLATION OF THE CONGRESS IN AN AUG. 22 LETTER TO  
THE GENERAL SECRETARY IN LONDON OF THE FEDERATION DENTAIRE  
INTERNATIONALE. BUT THE FEDERATION DECIDED TO GO AHEAD WITH  
THE CONGRESS, AND THE THREE NORDIC DENTIST ASSOCIATIONS WILL  
BOYCOTT IN PROTEST, SAID THE SWEDISH SPOKESMAN TODAY.
