X/4 C/S - GOVERNMENT DECLARATION FOR NATIONAL ASSEMBLY (RELEADS

CN 131)

MUNICH, SEPT 5 (CMD) -- A MEETING OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK GOVERNMENT TODAY DISCUSSED PREPARATIONS OF A GOVERNMENT DECLARATION TO BE PRESENTED IN THE NEXT FEW DAYS TO THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY, RADIO PRAGUE REPORTED TONIGHT.

THE RADIO SAID THAT THE DOCUMENT IS TO INCLUDE THE MOST IMPORTANT PRINCIPLES AND TASKS OF THE GOVERNMENT, WHICH STEM FROM THE CURRENT SITUATION, AND FROM THE CONCLUSIONS OF THE MOSCOW TALKS, AS WELL AS FROM THE NEEDS OF INTERNAL AND FOREIGN POLICY.

THE RADIO SAID THAT DURING THE MEETING, THE GOVERNMENT HAD HIGHLY ASSESSED THE UNITY AND PRUDENCE OF ALL CITIZENS AND THEIR EFFORTS AIMED AT OVERCOMING THE DIFFICULTIES CAUSED BY THE TEMPORARY INTERRUPTION OF PRODUCTION AND TRANSPORTATION.

THE RADIO SAID THAT THE GOVERNMENT TODAY PASSED A DRAFT LAW ACCORDING TO WHICH PRISONS WOULD BE TRANSFERRED FROM THE INTERIOR MINISTRY TO THE JUSTICE MINISTRY.

THE RADIO SAID THAT THIS MEASURE WAS DESIGNED TO STRENGTHEN GUARANTEES CONCERNING THE CONSISTENT OBSERVANCE OF SOCIAL LEGALITY BY SEPARATING THE EXECUTION OF IMPRISONMENT AND DETENTION FROM THE ACTIVITY OF SECURITY ORGANS. (RADIO PRAGUE DOMESTIC/M SEPT 5, 1900)
