

X/4 C/S -- ADN UNHAPPY OVER RUDE PRAVO EDITORIAL (WCN 84)

PRAGUE, SEPT 5 (CMD) -- EAST GERMANY'S OFFICIAL ADN NEWS AGENCY SAID TONIGHT THAT THE CZECHOSLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY ORGAN RUDE PRAVO HAD FAILED TODAY TO GIVE ITS READERS DETAILED ADVICE ON HOW BEST TO IMPLEMENT THE AGREEMENT REACHED AT MOSCOW BETWEEN CZECHOSLOVAKIA AND THE SOVIET UNION.

ADN SAID THAT THE CZECHOSLOVAK PARTY ORGAN HAD SAID IN RESPONSE TO READERS INQUIRIES THAT "THE ONLY REAL WAY OUT OF THE PRESENT SITUATION WAS THE POSITIVE FULFILLMENT OF THE TASKS SET BY THE MOSCOW NEGOTIATIONS."

HOWEVER, RUDE PRAVO HAD NOT OUTLINED THESE TASKS AND HAD MERELY REFERRED ITS READERS TO A STATEMENT ISSUED BY DEPUTY PREMIER FRANTISEK HAMOUZ ON WEDNESDAY.

BUT, SAID ADN, THE HAMOUZ STATEMENT HAD NOT CONTAINED "ONE WORD ABOUT THE FIGHT AGAINST PROVOCATEURS AND ANTI-SOCIALIST ELEMENTS OR THE NECESSITY OF SMASHING COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARY UNDERGROUND ORGANIZATIONS."
