X/4 C/S PLENARY MEETING OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY ON SEPT 13

(RELEADS CN 106)

MUNICH, SEPT 5 (CMD) -- RADIO PRAGUE REPORTED THAT THE PRESIDUM OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK NATIONAL ASSEMBLY, WHICH MET TODAY IN PRAGUE, DECIDED TO CONVENE THE PLENARY MEETING OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY ON SEPT 13.

THE RADIO SAID THAT THE PRESIDUM ASKED THE DEPUTIES OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY TO COME TO PRAGUE THREE DAYS BEFORE THE PLENARY SESSION TO STUDY APPROPRIATE MATERIALS AND TAKE PART IN THE MEETINGS OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY COMMITTEES.

THE RADIO SAID THAT DURING TODAY'S MEETING THE MEMBERS OF THE PRESIDUM OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY ACQUAINTED THEMSELVES WITH LETTERS OF PRESIDENT LUDVIK SVOBODA CONCERNING THE REPLACEMENT OF JOSEF PAVEL AS MINISTER OF THE INTERIOR BY JAN PELNAR AND CONCERNING THE RECALL OF PROFESSOR OTA SIK FROM THE FUNCTION OF DEPUTY PREMIER.

THE PRESIDUM ALSO EXPRESSED AGREEMENT CONCERNING THE PRESENTATION TO THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY OF THE DRAFT LAW ON THE NATIONAL FRONT.

THE PRESIDUM OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY FURTHER RECOMMENDED THAT THE SUPREME COURT AND THE MINISTRY OF JUSTICE WORK OUT QUESTIONS CONNECTED WITH THE CONSTITUTIONAL AND ADMINISTRATIVE JUDICIARY IN CONNECTION WITH A PREPARED AMENDMENT OF THE CONSTITUTION," SAID THE RADIO.
