X/4 C/S -2ND ADD RADIOS REPORT ABOUT SITUATION (CN 168) XXX NIGHT

THE ENGLISH-LANGUAGE SERVICE OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK RADIO TONIGHT (1915) ALSO PUBLISHED THE GOVERNMENT PRESIDUM REPORT ON THE PROGRESS OF CERTAIN BRANCHES OF THE ECONOMY.

THE RADIO SAID:

"... THE REPORT SAYS THAT THE SITUATION IS GRADUALLY BECOMING MORE NORMAL, EVEN THOUGH THERE ARE CONSIDERABLE DIFFICULTIES, ESPECIALLY IN TRANSPORT AND THE BUILDING INDUSTRY.

"THE CZECHOSLOVAK WORKING PEOPLE ARE ENDEAVORING TO MAKE GOOD THE LOSSES CAUSED TO PRODUCTION BY ORGANIZING SPECIAL SHIFTS AND WORKING OVERTIME.

THE KLEMENT GOTTWALD FOUNDRY AT OSTRAVA SUFFERED A LOSS OF SOME 64 (SIXTYFOUR) MILLION KORUNAS, BUT THE WORKERS MADE GOOD PART OF THIS BY WORKING A SPECIAL DUBCEK SHIFT LAST SATURDAY.
