

X/4 C/S - K-231 AND NON-PARTY PEOPLE CLUB NOT APPROVED

MUNICH,, SEPT 5 -- (CMD) -- THE CZECHOSLOVAK INTERIOR MINISTRY HAS NOT RPT NOT APPROVED THE STATUTES OF TWO CZECHOSLOVAK ORGANIZATIONS WHICH WERE CREATED EARLIER THIS YEAR.

ONE IS CALLED K-231 WHICH WANTED TO UNITE ALL CZECHOSLOVAKS WHO HAVE BEEN ILLEGALLY CONDEMNED AND PERSECUTED AFTER FEB. 1948. THE OTHER IS THE CLUB OF COMMITTED NON-PARTY PEOPLE.

CZECHOSLOVAK TELEVISION SAID TONIGHT THAT IN THE CASE OF K-231 THE MINISTRY PROCEEDS FROM THE FACT THAT THE LAW ON COURT REHABILITATIONS, MEASURES OF THE GOVERNMENT AND MEASURES OF OTHER STATE BODIES FULLY SECURE THE RIGHTS AND THE JUSTIFIED NEEDS OF REHABILITATED CITIZENS."

THE MINISTRY SAID THE ACTIVITIES OF K-231 "APPEAR TO BE SUPERFLUOUS."

IN THE CASE OF THE NON-PARTY PEOPLE CLUB, THE MINISTRY CAME TO THE CONCLUSION THAT THE PROPOSED CLUB "HAS THE CHARACTER OF A POLITICAL ORGANIZATION AND DOES NOT RPT NOT CORRESPOND TO THE AIMS OF COLUNTARY ORGANIZATIONS.
