X/4 C/S -- AIR TRAFFIC TO IMPROVE TOMORROW

MUNICH, SEPT 5 -- (CMD) -- RADIO PRAGUE SAID TONIGHT CZECHOSLOVAKIA'S CIVIL AVIATION WOULD MAKE ANOTHER STEP TOWARD NORMALIZATION TOMORROW WITH THE INTRODUCTION OF FLIGHTS ON THE LINE CONNECTING PRAGUE WITH BRNO, SLIAC, PIESTANY AND KOSICE.

THE RADIO SAID THAT FULL NORMALIZATION AND SAFETY IN AIR TRAFFIC COULD BE ACHIEVED ONLY IF FOREIGN MILITARY PLANES KEPT TO AIR ROUTES AND IF MILITARY EQUIPMENT WAS REMOVED FROM AREAS DANGEROUSLY CLOSE TO LANDING STRIPS, THE RADIO SAID.

THESE CONDITIONS DO NOT YET EXIST TO A SUFFICIENT EXTENT AT THE AIRPORTS OF PRAGUE, BRNO, BRATISLAVA, KOSICE, OSTRAVA, SLIAC, PREROV AND PIESTANY, IT SAID.

IT IS EXPECTED THAT A MAXIMUM NORMALIZATION OF INTERNAL AIR TRAFFIC WILL HAVE TAKEN PLACE BY SEPTEMBER 14 WHEN THE INTERNATIONAL BRNO TRADE FAIR BEGINS, THE RADIO SAID.
