

"THE FIRST EXTREME," HE SAID, ARE PEOPLE WHO BELIEVE THAT THE "ENTRANCE OF THE ALLIED ARMIES INTO OUR TERRITORY, THE MOSCOW TALKS, CERTAIN RESTRICTIONS IN OUR WORK... PROVIDE THE OCCASION FOR A RETURN TO PRE-JANUARY CONDITIONS... THEY ARE OF THE OPINION THAT WE SHOULD RETURN TO THE TIMES OF ANTONIN NOVOTNY, THAT WE SHOULD THROW AWAY EVERYTHING WHICH WE HAVE DONE IN OUR COUNTRY AFTER JANUARY, THAT THESE PEOPLE SHOULD SOMEHOW RETURN TO THEIR PLACES."

HUSAK SAID THAT "UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES MUST WE RETURN TO THE PRE-JANUARY CONDITIONS, AND WE WILL NOT RETURN..."

ON THE CONTRARY, THE "CONTINUATION OF THE POLICY UPON WHICH OUR PARTY HAS EMBARKED AFTER JANUARY IS THE GENERAL POLITICAL LINE OF OUR PARTY....," HE SAID.

"THEREFORE, LET THE PEOPLE NOT BE MISLED WHO THINK THAT THEIR TIME HAS COME, THAT THEY CAN RETURN TO THE TIMES OF BACILEK AND NOVOTNY..." SAID HUSAK.

HE SAID THAT THE SECOND EXTREME IS THE CONTINUATION OF THOSE "RIGHTIST" TENDENCIES, WHICH WERE IN EXISTENCE IN THE COUNTRY BEFORE THE AUGUST EVENTS, AND WHICH WERE STRENGTHENED AFTER AUGUST 21.

THESE TENDENCIES, HE SAID, "REJECT THE AGREEMENTS CONCLUDED IN MOSCOW," AND THUS IN ESSENCE REJECT THE COURSE WHICH WAS OUTLINED BY THE SLOVAK PARTY CONGRESS AND BY THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY.

HUSAK ALSO SAID THAT AFTER THE EXTRAORDINARY CONGRESS OF THE SLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY A RELAXATION BEGAN TO TAKE PLACE AMONG THE MASSES OF MILLIONS OF PEOPLE IN THE COUNTRY.

HE SAID "NEGATIVE" STATEMENTS COULD BE ALSO HEARD IN THE PARTY ORGANIZATIONS AND IN THE PUBLIC EXPRESSING DOUBTS AND EVEN DISAGREEMENTS.

HOWEVER, HE ADDED THAT IT COULD BE SAID THAT THE STAND WHICH WAS TAKEN AT THE RECENT SLOVAK EXTRAORDINARY PARTY CONGRESS IS TODAY THE STAND OF ALL CZECH AND SLOVAK COMMUNISTS OR AT LEAST THOSE WHO SUPPORT THE LEADER OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK PARTY, ALEXANDER DUBCEK.
