X/4 - YUGO - ECONOMIC BASIS FOR PRESS CRITICISM

LJUBLJANA, SEPT 6 (CMD) - THE PROCESSES OF ECONOMIC REFORM IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA, RUMANIA AND YUGOSLAVIA HAVE BECOME THE CHIEF TARGET FOR ATTACKS IN THE POLISH PRESS, ACCORDING TO AN EDITORIAL IN THE YUGOSLAV DAILY NEWSPAPER DELO.

THE DELO EDITORIAL REMINDS POLAND THAT SOME OF THE ECONOMIC THEORIES CRITICISED ARE THE ONES SUPPORTED BY POLISH PLANNERS, ACCORDING TO A TANJUG SUMMARY OF THE EDITORIA.

THE NEWSPAPER CONCLUDES THAT THERE WERE DEEP-SEATED ECONOMIC REASONS BEHIND THE CZECHOSLOVAK CRISES AND THAT COMECON (CEMA) "IS LIKELY TO BE GIVEN THE ROLE OF CONDUCTOR OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT" FOR THE EASTERN EUROPEAN SOCIALIST STATES, THE TANJUG SUMMARY CONCLUDES.
