

X/4 C/S - SLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE ON SITUATION

MUNICH, SEP 6 (CMD)-THE SLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY'S CENTRAL COMMITTEE LAST NIGHT EXPRESSED ITS VIEWS ON CZECHOSLOVAKIA'S FUTURE CONSTITUTIONAL ARRANGEMENT AND THE CURRENT POLITICAL SITUATION.

IT ALSO SAID THAT THE ABSENCE OF ANY "ANTI-SOCIALIST AND ANTI-COMMUNIST" MANIFESTATIONS "DURING THE (RECENT) DIFFICULT DAYS" WERE "PROOF THAT THE ROAD TOWARD SOCIALISM...CONTAINED IN THE ACTION PROGRAM OF THE PARTY HAD WON THE SUPPORT OF THE GREAT MAJORITY OF THE PEOPLE."

THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE ALSO EXPRESSED ITS "FULL SOLIDARITY WITH THE HIGHEST REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE AND PARTY," WHILE AT THE SAME TIME EXPRESSING THE BELIEF THAT "CONSISTENT IMPLEMENTATION OF THE AGREEMENTS" ENTERED INTO AT MOSCOW SHOWS THE "REAL WAY OUT OF THE COMPLICATED SITUATION" NOW OBTAINING IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

THE SLOVAK PARTY BODY ALSO SAID THAT THESE OBLIGATIONS ARE AN "UNAVOIDABLE STEP TOWARD THE NORMALISATION OF RELATIONS AMONG SOCIALIST STATES."

LIFE IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA WAS RETURNING TO NORMAL OWING "TO THE UNDERSTANDING AND THE UNIFIED STAND OF THE WORKING PEOPLE."

THE STATEMENT OF THE SLOVAK CENTRAL COMMITTEE ISSUED IN BRATISLAVA ALSO SAID THAT THE UNITY OF SLOVAKS AND CZECHS HAD DEEPENED IN THE PAST TWO WEEKS.
