

MUNICH, SEPT 6 (CNR)--THE COURSE OF DEVELOPMENTS IN OCCUPIED CZECHOSLOVAKIA CONTINUES AS A CENTER OF INTEREST IN THE WORLD TODAY, AFTER NEW SLOVAK PARTY LEADER GUSTAV HUSAK SAID THE NATION'S POLICY WILL CONTINUE TO BE BASED ON THE GENERAL LINE ADOPTED BY THE CZECHOSLOVAK PARTY LAST JANUARY.

THE HEAD OF THE OFFICE SET UP BY THE CZECHOSLOVAK GOVERNMENT TO CONTROL THE PRESS HAS SAID THERE WOULD BE NO RETURN TO THE OLD BUREAUCRATIC METHODS OF CENSORSHIP, AND THE TRADE UNION ORGAN PRACE REAPPEARED TO JOIN OTHER NEWSPAPERS WHICH HAVE RESUMED PUBLICATION.

THERE HAS BEEN SOME CRITICISM OF DEVELOPMENTS IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA IN THE WARSAW PACT PRESS, AND CRITICISM OF THE OCCUPATION BY SUCH COMMUNIST LEADERS AS YUGOSLAVIA'S MARSHAL TITO AND ITALY'S LUIGI LONGO AS WELL AS BY WESTERN OFFICIALS.

TALKS BETWEEN CZECH AND SLOVAK LEADERS ON FEDERALIZATION ARE TO CONTINUE TODAY IN BRATISLAVA AFTER THE TWO DELEGATIONS REACHED AGREEMENT ON AN OUTLINE FOR WORK ON THE MATTER.

ANOTHER PLENARY SESSION OF THE CONFERENCE OF NON-NUCLEAR STATES IS SCHEDULED FOR TODAY IN GENEVA.

WEST GERMANY'S CHANCELLOR KURT GEORG KIESINGER IS TO HOLD TALKS TODAY WITH TURKISH PREMIER SULEYMAN DEMIREL IN ANKARA, WHERE HE ARRIVED YESTERDAY ON THE FIRST LEG OF A TRIP THAT WILL ALSO TAKE HIM TO IRAN AND AFGHANISTAN.

ON THE LIGHTER SIDE, THE BUCHAREST STATE OPERETTA ENSEMBLE IN ITS FIRST ENGAGEMENT IN A WESTERN CITY WILL PERFORM EMMERICH KALMAN'S "GRAEFIN MARIZZA" AT WEST BERLIN'S THEATER DES WESTENS FROM SEPT 6 TO 19. THE PRODUCTION, WHICH BRINGS A TROUPE OF 150 RUMANIAN ARTISTS TO WEST BERLIN, WILL BE PRESENTED IN GERMAN.

THE SUMMER FESTIVAL OF PARIS CONTINUES TO OFFER A VARIETY OF CONCERTS IN THE CHURCHES OF THE FRENCH CAPITAL. IN THE BEAUTIFUL, ANCIENT CHAPEL OF SAINT-GERMAIN-L'AUXERROIS, JUST BEHIND THE LOUVRE MUSEUM, THE BACH COLLEGIUM FROM FRIBOURG, SWITZERLAND, PERFORMS THE MAGNIFICENT MAGNIFICAT AS WELL AS SEVERAL CANTATAS. FOR THE OCCASION, THE CHURCH WILL BE ILLUMINATED TONIGHT.
