THE WALLS OF THE BULGARIAN PAVILLION ARE COVERED WITH PICTURES OF SAILBOATS, BLOND BATHING BEAUTIES, AND LONG STRETCHES OF SANDY BEACHES, WHILE AN ADVERTISEMENT CALLS ATTENTION TO THE PLOVDIV FAIR LATER THIS MONTH.

THE HUNGARIANS HAVE THE SMALLEST OF THE EAST EUROPEAN EXHIBITIONS AND HAVE GONE IN LEAST FOR HEAVY MACHINERY SAMPLES OF THEIR PRODUCTION. THE SHOW ARE OF KITCHEN POTS AND PANS, GLASSWARE, SHOVELS, PITCHFORKS, SODA WATER SIPHONS, ELECTRIC LIGHT BULBS, OFFICE EQUIPMENT, TELEVISION SETS, EQUIPMENT TO TEACH FOREIGN LANGUAGES, ALARM CLOCKS AND EYE GLASSES.

IN THE POLISH EXHIBITION THERE IS AN UNUSUALLY LARGE NUMBER OF CHILDRENS TOOL KITS, SKIIS, ROLLER SKATES, DOLLARS, DOMINOES, BOYS TENTS, CHILDRENS MUSICAL INSTRUMENTS, DOLL TEA SETS FOR LITTLE GIRLS, AND EVEN A RED INDIAN SUIT COMPLETE WITH FEATHERED HEADDRESS. IN ADDITION, THERE IS THE USUAL KITCHENWARE AND RADIO BATTERIES AS WELL AS STATIONARY EXERCISE BICYCLES, LANTERNS, LOCKS, SCISSORS, AND POLISH TINNED FOOD WITH LABELS IN GERMAN AND ENGLISH.

THE RUMANIAN STAND HAS EXAMPLES OF RUMANIAN-MADE WOMENS DRESSES, COATS, AND SHOES AND THEIR COUNTERPARTS IN THE MENS APPAREL DEPARTMENT.

ADDITIONALLY, THE RUMANIANS SHOW EXAMPLES OF EAST EUROPEAN-MADE AUTO RADIOS, BATTERIES, BICYCLES, AUTO TIRES, STOVES, AND TOILET FIXTURES. THERE ARE ALSO WASHING MACHINES, MEDICINES, PAINT, TELEPHONES, AND SEWING MACHINES. IN AN OPEN-AIR LOT BESIDE THE PAVILLION THE RUMANIANS ARE EXHIBITING TRACTORS, TRAILERS, TRUCKS, AND HEAVY AGRICULTURAL EQUIPMENT.
