X/4/9 C/S -- POLISH ARMY PAPER ATTACKS RUMANIA AND YUGOSLAVIA  
(WITH CN 38)

MUNICH, SEP 6 (CMD)-- THE POLISH ARMY NEWSPAPER, ZOLNIERZ WOLNOSCI, ATTACKED YUGOSLAVIA AND RUMANIA TODAY BECAUSE OF THEIR CRITICISM OF THE INVASION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

THE POLISH PRESS AGENCY, PAP, SAID ZOLNIERZ WOLNOSCI ALSO CRITIZED COMMUNIST CHINA, CLAIMING THAT CHINESE POLICIES HAD CAUSED THE UNITED STATES TO ATTACK NORTH VIETNAM.

"WE HAVE TO STATE WITH REGRET," ZOLNIERZ WOLNOSCI WAS QUOTED AS SAYING," THAT NOT RPT NOTALL THE COMMUNIST PARTIES AND GOVERNMENTS OFSOCIALIST STATES UNDERSTAND THE INSEPARABILITY OF IDEAS OF PATRIOTISM AND INTERNATIONALISM.

"WE HAVE IN MIND IN THIS CONNECTION YUGOSLAVIA AND RUMANIA. FOLLOWING AN ABSTRACT COMPREHENSION OF THE SLOGAN OF SOVEREIGNTY, GIVING PRIORITY TO ABSTRACT NATIONAL INTERESTS, THEY HAVE SLIPPED AWAY FROM THE POSITIONS OF THE PROLETARIAN INTERNATIONALISM.

"PROTESTING AGAINST THE ENTRY OF THE ALLIED TROOPS INTO CZECHOSLOVAKIA THEY FOUND THEMSELVES ON THE SAME LINE AS THE IMPERIALIST POLITICAL SUBVERSION, PROVIDING THUS ARGUMENTS TO THE ANTI-COMMUNIST PROPAGANDA.

"THE EXISTENCE OF SOCIALIST YUGOSLAVIA ITSELF, AS WELL AS RUMANIA WOULD BE IMPOSSIBLE WERE IT NOT RPT NOT FOR THE MATERIAL AND MILITARY MIGHT OF THE WHOLE SOCIALIST COMMUNITY, WERE IT NOT RPT NOT FOR THE INTERNATIONALIST TIES LINKING OUR SOCIALIST FAMILY."
